VICTIMS

A lieutenant, Ebraheem Ali Jumaa, from PLA has died in clashes in Sheik-Meskeem town in Dara'a. The news from the Dara'a comes to assure what AGPS had revealed few days ago, that some PLA units participate in the conflict with Assad regime in Sheik-Meskeen. Jumaa was announced dead by a Facebook page affiliated PLA.

RECENT UPDATES

Al-Nusra Front has released two members of Fateh movement. Bahaa Al-Ameen and Samer Shebli were arrested by the fighters of Al-Nusra with charge of cooperating with Assad regime and the Palestinian faction of PFLP-GC before they have been released few hours later. It is noteworthy that clashes erupted between Al-Nusra and ISIS in Yarmook camp Yesterday after months of alliance.



In Aleppo, The Syrian security arrested Mazen Abu Dhayes in Al-Nairab camp. Abu Dhayes, pro-Assad, was detained with charge of smuggling



soldiers to Turkey. On the other hand, Palestinian families are still emigrate from Al-Nairab camp. The people, who fled the camp due to the heavy security restrictions, head to Turkey or west Europe.

Meanwhile, Jafra charity provided assistance to displaced people from Yarmook camp to Yalda. The campaign entitled "Raja'een" (means we are returning) launched by Jafra owing to suffering of people from the camp. It is worth noting that all relief organisations had been closed in the wake of ISIS dominance of Yarmook camp last April. It is indicated that many activist were assassinated in the camp.

In south country in Dara'a, Palestinian refugees are suffering from the constant shelling and military actions. The Palestinian camp of Dara'a, located just 300 meter away from the city centre, is subjected to heavy bombardment and explosive barrels since May 2012. It is worth mentioning that no running water in the camp for 663 day, and the electricity runs for 4 hours-average a day. The camp's inhabitants are enforced to use the contaminated artesian wells with difficulties of extracting the water because of the power cutting.





The horrific situation in the camp resulting in spreading of rats in the abandoned building which is the main cause of some diseases.

Moving to Lebanon, and coincided to the trough which started in the region. Palestinians of Syria Committee carried out an inspection tour on Palestinian refugees in Bekaa province where 950 family live. The committee provided heating-fuel to some destitute families in the area.

In the same context, The Palestinian Red Crescent with cooperating of the Follow-up of Displaced Palestinian Committee in Lebanon, have completed a First Aid training course in Alawda club in Wadi-Alzaini south Lebanon. The course was carried out, specifically, for Palestinians from Syria. Dr Riyad Abu Alenain, the manager of ALhamshary hospital handed out the certificates to the trainees at the end of the course.

It is worth noting that 500 Palestinian family from Syria live in Wadi-Alzaini out of nearly 42000.



STATISTICS

AGPS revealed a new report regarding the amount of Palestinian victims over the past 6 months of 2015. The report indicated to a significant drop



in the rate of Palestinian victims, compared to the same period of 2014. The rate of killings have fallen from 262 in the second half of 2014 to 177 victim in the same half of 2015, AGPS said. The findings illustrate that victims in 2015 are divided to 163 were killed inside Syria and 14 outside, and 150 males to 27 females. Children account for 10.7% of casualties. The bloody month, according to the report, was august 2015 where 49 Palestinian had been killed, whereas, December was the least one with 21 victim.

Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 25 January 2016

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 42,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command), continued for 925 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1014 days, water cut for 503 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 186 victims .*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 809 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1002 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 663 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL-SaiedaZainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.*
