### ***Recent Updates***

*Activists confirmed to the AGPS that water cut at Khan Dannon camp in Damascus suburb, following news reported that sewage mixed with drinking water and resulted in severe pollution at water network.*

*Water completely cuts every day except for one day per week, mostly coincides with power cut, while only residents who have generators can fill the water reservoirs.*



*The Syrian security and army stopped feeding the camp through the water network coming from the adjacent areas since 9 September 2014, forcing relief institutions working inside the camp to reclaim and operate some artesian wells.*

*Meanwhile ISIS and Nusra exacerbated the suffering of the people of Yarmouk after they imposed control over the camp since the beginning of April 2015.*





*In addition, they prevented the residents to obtain water since violent clashes broke out between them in 7 April 2016, which resulted in the deterioration of living conditions after tens of families failed to leave the conflict areas to safer areas, as they were prevented-such as the rest of residents in the besieged camp- to have water extracted from the artesian wells.*

*On the other hand, Reuters news agency quoted from the Italian Coastguard that Italian ships helped saving more than (2600) immigrants while trying to reach Europe from North Africa in the past twenty-four hours.*

*The agency added that about 2,000 immigrants was rescued off the coast of Libya were on board (14) elastically and a larger boat during the rescue operations carried out by the Italian Navy and Coastguard along with MSF and an Irish naval vessel.*

*For its part, humanitarian organizations reported that the sea route between Libya and Italy is the main way now being followed by asylum seekers who come for Europe after the conclusion of an agreement between the EU and Turkey regarding migrants much decreased flow of migrants arriving to Greece.*





*Resources confirmed that Greek police evacuate Aadomina refugee camp on the border with Macedonia to take them to a nearby evacuation centers. At least 200 policemen participated in the evacuation process backed by about twenty mechanisms.*

*Thousands of immigrants, including Palestinian Syrians and Syrians have reached to this camp on the border with Macedonia, which was closed early March, after the European and Turkish agreements made thousands of Palestinian and Syrian refugees who fled from Syria in a new and harsh suffering, especially those who are on the Macedonian border and in Greece. Land borders, connected to the European countries of asylum, were closed; the marine guard in the Aegean Sea prevents the arrival of new immigrants to the Greek islands.*

### ***Civil Work Committees***

*The international campaign to preserve the Palestinian identity "Intimaa" revived the 68th anniversary of Nakba in Baalbek on Sunday 22 May 2016 in cooperation with Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon, Al Israa scouted, and the Islamic League.*

*The ceremony, which was attended by representatives of the Palestinian factions and crowd of Palestinian people, included a play about the story of Palestine people, heritage exhibition, and popular foods.*



***Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 24/05/2016:***

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1074 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1135 days, water was cut for 624 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 928 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1 119 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 781 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
