### *"ISIS Keeps Restricting the Trapped People of Yarmouk"*

### ***Recent Updates***

*The remained Palestinian families in Al Yarmouk Camp in Damascus suffers from several disgraceful practices. Those practices are being performed by ISIS after their control over Al Yarmouk with the help of Al – Nusra's Front soldiers since the beginning of April 2015.*

*People have confirmed to Action Group reporter that ISIS had closed all the alternative schools reducing them into two schools with a new curriculum of ISIS's own ideas. It also controls Jarmak School 'one of UNRWA's schools, and reopens it with a new name which is "Al Aqsa School" and a new curriculum from its own preparation. Consequently, people have stopped sending their children to those schools.*



*Some activists have asserted that ISIS's men had been harassing women while passing through its blockades under the pretext of abiding "the Islamic dress" in their perspective. People described them as liars and hypocrites. It's noteworthy that the camp undergoes a suffocating siege by the Syrian army and PFGC from one side. And the transgressions of ISIS, which controls large areas of the camp, from another side.*



*On the other hand, Handarat and its outskirts have witnessed fierce clashes between the Syrian regime's forces and the Syrian opposition groups. Local media sources have reported that Syrian regime and pro-regime Al Quds brigade had succeeded yesterday morning to delve Handarat in the north of Aleppo after heavy bombardment upon the camp and the armed opposition groups which led to its withdrawal, a number of casualties in both sides and a massive destruction in the camp.*

*It should be noticed that all the residents of Handarat had been displaced after the fierce battles before (1239) days. It ended up with the opposition control over the camp.*

*In other context, the families of Palestinian tortured victims who died in Syrian regime's prisons said to Action Group reporter that their sons' certain death news came after concentrated efforts through Intermediaries or military court to know about their fate. Then the Syrian security officers enforces them to sign fake death certificates from Tishreen Military Hospital claiming that their sons died because of heart attack.*

*Huda (fake name), the wife of one of the Palestinian Victims stated to the reporter of the group that after severe suffering to know her husbands' fate in Syrian prisons she has been delivered the signed-fake certificate that her husband died because of heart attack. Threatening her to keep silent and not to ask about him again and that she was lucky to get that certificate.*

*she has also confirmed to the Group reporter that her husband had been seen by one of the recent released prisoners after delivering the fake*



*death certificate. Similarly, some activists confirmed that a number of victims' families were informed from the same source about seeing their sons in security centers or Sednaya military prison after delivering the fake certificates.*

*Turning to another subject, German embassy in Beirut has announced via its website that it's going to change the Scheduling System so that all the reunion applicants can get benefit from it. And they will be considered as legal refugee in Germany to shorten their waiting period.*

*It also confirmed that the changes in the scheduling system won't delay any applicants. On the contrary, it came to lessen the long time and reduce the waiting period for them.*

*It's worth noting that hundreds of Palestinian Syrian families are waiting their reunion schedules in the European countries. Unfortunately, as a result of all the European embassies closure in Damascus, all the paperwork for Syrians and Palestinian Syrians needs to travel to a neighboring country. Immigrants used to choose Lebanon. Although the family's entry into Lebanon was with a proved procedural aim with no intention to stay there, border authorities had prevented Palestinian Syrian families from entering its lands.*

### ***Palestinians of Syria Numbers and Statistics until 24/9/2016***

- *(15500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan.*
- *(42,500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon.*

- *(6000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015.*
- *(8000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey.*
- *(1000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza.*
- *More than (79,000) Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid-2016.*
- *Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for (1194) consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than (1255) days. water was cut for (745) days respectively. The number of siege victims is (187).*
- *Sabina Camp: Regular Army is still forbidding the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for (1047) days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about (1239) days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Daraa Camp: - It is now almost (897) days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were totally destroyed.*
- *Jermana, AL Sayeda -ZeinabAl Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
