Bombing Targets Khan Al Sheih Camps

- An academic Palestinian man was killed due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons.
- Water cut in the Yarmouk and Daraa camps is still continuous.
- The Action Group issues the English version of its documentary report “Camps without Refugees”.
- 3 victims from Rokn Al Dein compound in Damascus were killed since the beginning of events in Syria.

Recent Updates

Bombing targeted Khan AL Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus suburb with a number of shells, as a shell was dropped at a house resulted in material damages, while another one was dropped at a street, followed by violent clashes sounds were heard from Zakia town. In terms of living aspect, all roads that link the camp with the adjacent areas are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih. In a related context a mortar shell was dropped at a house in Khan Dannon camp resulted in material damages, while the residents of the camp are living in a state of tension due to the security situation deterioration, as they complain of economic crises such as the lack of food, fuel, power and water cut for long periods.

Meanwhile, the residents of Daraa camp are suffering of the water cut for 224 days respectively and for 77 days in the Yarmouk camp, as the water cut is exacerbate their living crises in both camps, since the Yarmouk



camp is still besieged by the regular army and groups of the PFGC, as Daraa camp is suffering of severe shortage of relief and medical services.

in a different context, the documentation team of the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria announced that the number of victims, from Rokn Al Dein compound in Damascus, who were killed since the beginning of the events in Syria, has reached 3 victims, two of them were killed due to torture and the other was killed by a car bomb. It is mentioned that Rokn Al Dein area is inhabited by hundreds of Palestinian Syrian families.

On the other hand, the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria issued an English version of the documentary report "Camps without Refugees".

The report is addressing, in 23 pages, the situation in "Sbeineh, Husseinia and Handarat" camps which had been emptied completely from its residents as a result of clashes and violence. Some of these camps have been controlled by the regime, the Palestinian factions and its public Committees, but their residents were prevented from returning to it, as in Sbeineh and Hosseinieh camps which are located in Damascus suburb. The other camps came under Syrian opposition control, but are still a war zone, as the case in Handarat camp near of Aleppo in northern Syria.

The report also provides detailed statistics for Palestinian victims of these camps, who died because of air, artillery and rocket bombing as well as clashes between the Syrian regime and the Syrian opposition, pointing out that these camps have been dumped and its people were dispersed under clear silence and inability by Palestinian and international official authorities. The report also noted that these official authorities have failed to provide the required protection to refugees and civilians stipulated in international conventions and the Global Charter for Human Rights, where Palestinian Syrian refugees became very needy to anything would restore their balance again, after events in Syria made them lose everything, and returned them back to the stage cannot determine the chances of temporally or spatially recovery, since they were displaced and resort through life extended for more than three years of crisis.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 24/11/2014

- *The number of Palestinian refugee victims in Syria has reached 2555.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 507 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 590 days, water was cut for 77 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.*
- *41 Palestinian refugees were killed outside of Syria.*
- *96 PLA members were killed due to Clashes in Syria.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 409 days respectively.*
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 379 days respectively.*
- ***Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for 579 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- ***Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost 224 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.*
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.*
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:** - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.*
- ***Al Nairab Camp:** - Power is still cut for more than a year.*
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.*
