"The Lebanese General Security Tightens the Situation of the Palestinians of Syria and Escalates the Arrest Campaign Against them, Hamas Demands the Lebanese Authorities to Find a Rapid Solution to Renew the Refugees Residencies"

Lebanon

Some Activists warned the Palestinian Syrian refugees to be careful on all Ein Al Helwa entrances and not going out but for the extreme necessity fearing to be arrested by the Lebanese General Security. The activists mentioned that the campaign arrest against the Palestinians of Syria is still continuous till today and became on the entire security checkpoint in Lebanon. Warns came after the Lebanese security arrested a number of the Palestinian refugees under the pretext of the expired residencies. It is noted that the Lebanese security seizes the ID of anyone who want to renew his residency and they delay the procedures to grant them the residencies.

For its side, Hamas called through Yasser Al Ali, the head of the Refugees Affairs officer in Lebanon, the Lebanese authorities to release the 14 Palestinian Syrian refugees that were arrested by the Lebanese Security checkpoint on the entrance of Ein Al Helwa from the side of AL Hesba in charge of not having a residency to stay in Lebanon. Al Ali mentioned that those procedures add more burdens on the Palestinian refugees which increase the pressure on the camp which is expected to explode in any moment and the arrest will impact the camp negatively.



Yaser Al Ali appealed the Lebanese government to put an end to this problem through an official decision that considers the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon as refugees that don't need to issue residencies in a



country that they are not tourists or visitors but they came escaping from a war area and all the war convictions are applied on them.

AL Ali insured that Hamas is following the situation of the detained people and contacts all the concerned parties to work to release them as soon as possible.

In the same context, the Palestinian Syrian Families performed a protest in front of Al Samou' school at Ein AL Helwa at Sidon south of Lebanon, protesting on the arrest campaign that they are exposed to by the checkpoints of the Lebanese General Security under the pretext of the expired residencies. The protestors also renewed their appeals to all the concerned sides of Human rights and the UN to interfere to release all the detained who are suffering of difficult situations.

Recent Updates

For the third day respectively, The Syrian warplanes continues to bomb the Palestinian camps and the surrounding areas with explosive barrels, Daraa camp southern of Syria was targeted yesterday with an explosive barrel that only caused material damage. The warplanes also targeted Al Saeed Street at Khan Al Shieh western vicinity with three explosive barrels, where the tension, instability, and safety prevailed among the residents of the Palestinian camps in Syria due to bombing their camps with explosive barrels. The last days witnessed the bombing Khan Al Shieh camp, Daraa camp and Al Muzareeb with 25 explosive barrels



which led to a number of victims and injured people and a mass damage in houses and properties.

In the same context, the Yarmouk camp was targeted with mortar shells that affected several areas of the camp and only led to material damages after a night of bombing with mortar shells and clashes on the crossings of Palestine Street and Yarmouk School areas between the Regular Army alongside with the Palestinian factions and the Opposition forces. The Relief office in cooperation with AL Nahda Charity implemented Iftar for the elder people in at Yarmouk camp.

Detainees

The Palestinian refugee Ahmed Al Khatib from Khan Al Shieh cam was arrested by the Syrian Army checkpoint in Dahnaya town in Damascus Suburb. In the same context, the AGPS documented that the Syrian Regime forces arrested 86 Palestinian refugees from Khan Al Shieh camp since the beginning of the Syrian war.



Civil Work Committees

The Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon Committee in cooperation with Al Quds charity organized a collective Ramadan Iftar for about 250 people from the residents of the Syrian camps who are displaced to Al Beddawi camp in northern of Lebanon. The number of The Palestinians of Syria refugees in Lebanon and who live at Al Beddawi camp is 850 families out of 44000 Palestinian Syrian refugees resorted to Lebanon escaping the ongoing war in Syria.



Hungary

Hungary on Tuesday suspended European Union asylum rules requiring it to take back refugees who have travelled through Hungary to other countries, and Brussels immediately called on it to clarify its action.

"Hungary's asylum system is overburdened, the most overburdened among EU member states affected by illegal immigration," a Hungarian government spokesman said.



In 2014, 43000 refugees crossed the borders with Serbia to Hungary, which is 175 Km. It is mentioned that Hungary is considered one of the most important crossing European countries through the neighboring countries such as Macedonia, Greece and then to Hungary and after Hungary to Austria. A lot of Palestinian Syrian refugees suffer because of their fingerprints due to the refusal of the Asylum European countries to grant them the residencies though some exceptions but the current decision forms their only lifeline, according to some analysts.

Numbers and Statistics till 24/6/2015

- *80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 896 detainees, and 398 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 727 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 797 days, water was cut for 287 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 608 days respectively.*

- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 589 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 791 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 434 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
