RECENT UPDATES

Yarmook camp witnessed a security tension between ISIS and Al-Nusar Front. The tension comes in the wake of talk of an imminent agreement between ISIS and Assad regime. The leaked agreement provides an exit to ISIS groups to Alhaja-Alaswad, the town south Damascus, which leaves Al-Nusra face-to face with the regime's forces. It is indicated that clashes had erupted between the two groups in Al-Oroba street few days ago.

In the meantime, an uncertain information has been leaked, that ISIS developed a plan aimed at ending Al-Nusra existence in Yarmook camp. In its turn, Al-Nusar Front put sand barriers in an anticipation of any surprise attack by ISIS.

On the different context, Palestine Charity Association has completed the distribution of firewood to displaced people from Yarmook camp. The (900) family, benefited from the firewood, constitute about half of the displaced Palestinians in the neighbouring towns of Yarmook. The distribution comes after UNRWA cutting its aid to Palestinians in Yarmook.





In Turkey, a high profile official from Ministry of Education have paid a visit to a Palestinian girl from Syria, Marya Faour. The visit, upon orders from the Minister of Education, comes to apologise for the girl after she was prevented from receiving her certificate from the school. The Turkish Minister of Education, Nabi Avgi, have instructed all schools across the country to facilitate the affairs of Palestinian students from Syria. It is worth mentioning that the certificate and some gifts were provided to Faour by the director of education in region.



Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 25 January 2016

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 42,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command), continued for 926 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1015*

days, water cut for 504 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 187 victims .

- *Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 810 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1003 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 664 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL-SaiedaZainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.*
