" Palestinians of Europe Conference Demands to Open the Yarmouk Road and to Enter Humanitarian Aid"

Palestinians of Europe Conference

Palestinians of Europe Conference confirmed in the closing statement that was issued yesterday evening that the conference cope with the renewable plight of the Palestinian people in Syria, and follow-up the tragedy of Yarmouk other camps with deep pain" .

The statement pointed out that "the continuing plight of the Palestinian people will not end but to activate the right of return to their land and their homes in Palestine".

The statement called for "not to impose any options on the people of Yarmouk camp, to open the camp to enter and exit as determined by its residents and the other camp's residents. The statement also called for "the need to open the way for humanitarian supplies to the residents of the camps and all population and displaced people there".

The statement stressed "the continuing efforts and campaigns to assign our people in this renewed plight in various possible ways, with the need for all States to be obliged to deal with refugees and displaced persons in a decent humanitarian way".

Chair of the Conference announced the adoption of all proposals and follow-up workshop of Palestinians of Syria, which was held within the conference events," and that it will do its capacity to translate these recommendations into reality, according to the potential offered by the Palestinian labor in the continent".

It is noteworthy that dozens of young Palestinian activists in Syria participated in the workshop, where they went out a set of recommendations that have been submitted to the presidency of the Conference.





For his part, Professor, "Tariq Hamoud," the AGPS coordinator, called the Palestinian leaders to put the file of Palestinians of Syria on the priorities of the Palestinian agendas, stressing the need for all international organizations to end their suffering, referring to their deteriorating humanitarian situation, as they were forced to access to the greatest parts of the world in Cambodia or stability in the bottom of the sea.



"Hamoud" call came during a speech at the opening session of the 13th Palestinians of Europe Conference, which was launched yesterday morning in the German capital Berlin.

On a related context, media workers of Yarmouk, families of the detainees and the martyrs of torture in Syrian prisons, the Palestinian families in Turkey camps, and detained families in Macedonian prisons sent messages and claims for the Palestinians of Europe Conference .

During the exhibition that was held yesterday under the title "A Cup of Coffee," the Palestinian Syrian artist "Anas Salama" manifested the suffering of the Palestinian refugees in the Yarmouk refugee camp, through paintings painted by the remains of coffee, within the artistic activities associated with the Palestinians of Europe Conference XIII.

Recent Updates

The AGPS correspondent reported that the Yarmouk Camp was exposed yesterday to bombing by the Syrian Army with mortar shells that targeted separate areas of the camp without any wounded people, coincided with clashes in the sides of the camp between the ISIS and Nusra from one side and the Palestinian Groups from the other side at the vicinity of Al



Rija square near Al Habeeb Al Mustafa mosque and on the Vegetables Market crossing and Palestine street. In the Southern side of Yarmouk Camp, clashes broke out between ISIS and Nusra against the militants of the Syrian Opposition of Sham Al Rasoul Brigade and Ababeel Houran and there is news about dead and wounded people. The AGPS correspondent added that three civilians were sniped at Al Ourouba Street by unknown snipers on the buildings of Yelda and looking on Al Ourouba Street after violent clashes in the area.



The events come in light of the siege continuation on Yarmouk that is imposed on the Camp by the PFGC and the Regular Army for 658 days respectively. The Yarmouk camp suffers of the water cut for more than 738 days and water cut for 228 days respectively and the prevention of the food and medical aid to the besieged people. It is referred that ISIS controls about 70% of the camp after breaking into the camp in the beginning of April 2015 in cooperation with Al Nusra Front and clashing with the Palestinian Groups, Aknaf Bait Al Maqdis and the Syrian Opposition on all sides of the Camp .

In a different context, the civil actions at Yarmouk camp called for participation in the public sit-in on Sunday 26th of April 2015 at 11:00 AM near the Daam Al Shabab center at Yarmouk under the title “We are staying at Yarmouk”, as to deny the news about that there are just 1000 at Yarmouk and to respond to the billboards on Yelda checkpoints that call the residents of Yarmouk to leave it in two days till they close Yelda checkpoint completely and prevent the entrance and the exit of people to the Camp.



It is referred that a delegation from Yarmouk, dignitaries and some members of the civil council visited the people of Yarmouk who were displaced to Yelda as to convince them to return back to their camp and not to leave it.

In Turkey, the Committee of the Yarmouk Palestinian Families from Syria to Turkey at Kilis city hold the humanitarian and manner responsibility of returning the refugees back to Syria to the official and civil sides after they gave up on their responsibility towards the families specially after returning five Palestinian families to Turkey. The families threatened to escalate their protest till they reach their voice and end their suffering by securing a decent life to their children .



It is mentioned that 49 Palestinian Syrian families at Kilis city launched an appeal demanding to help them in getting a decent life at Kilis city south of Turkey after closing the shelter center that they were in and the cut of all aid. The appeal that the AGPS received that all sides let the families down at the time there are no choices but to go back to Syria or to be exiled to Madin camp which is similar to a military base.

It is mentioned that thousands of Palestinians escaped Syria to Turkey due to bombing their camps and being in the ongoing conflict, the unofficial statistics refer to that the number of the Palestinians of Syria refugees in Turkey is between 3000 to 5000 Palestinian Syrian refugees.



The refugees suffer of living difficulties concerning work, language, and legal position which prompted them to ride the death boats to reach the European countries searching for a decent life.

Numbers and Statistics till 25/4/2015-:

- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 658 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 738 days, water was cut for 2278 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 174 victims .
- ٨٠,٠٠٠ Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 558 days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 529 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 731 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 374 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
