"Palestinian Parties Facilitate the Return of Palestinian Syrian Youth from Europe to Fight alongside the Syrian Regime Forces"

Recent Updates

Multiple sources confirmed to the AGPS that some Palestinian groups affiliated with the Syrian regime communicated with Palestinian Syrian refugees in Europe to convince them to return to Syria to fight alongside the Syrian regime forces.

Our correspondent confirmed earlier that a number of Palestinian families and young people, who migrated to Germany, returned recently to the Neirab camp in Aleppo, in addition to the arrival of two families and three young men during the past few days, as another family arrived at the camp from Switzerland two weeks ago.



Media resources affiliated with the Syrian opposition published photographs of what it described as a group of young Palestinians from Germany returned and joined the Syrian regime, under initiative and coordination of the commander of "al-Quds Brigade" militia, Mohammed Saeed and a number of leaders of the militia led by the Deputy leader, Adnan al-Sayyed and chief of operations, Mohammed Rafi.



According to the newspaper, the "returnees" are a group of people from Neirab camp in Aleppo, who previously went to Germany for asylum and recently returned through facilitation of the regime secured by AlQuds Brigade militias.

In the meantime, "Zaman Alwasl" Syrian newspaper activated and published through its website a service of searching the names of those who are wanted to the mandatory and reserve military service of the Regime forces. The service also includes those who did not join military service, in addition to the names of those who were sentenced in absentia provisions for not joining the regime's army by the Single military judge in the governorates of which they are from.

Activists said that lists include thousands of refugees who are opponents to the Syrian regime; names of Syrians and Palestinians Syrian who are wanted for the regime to be recruited in the army. The newspaper confirmed that the leaks obtained more than half a million names wanted for military service in the Syrian regime's army, including the Palestine Liberation Army in Syrian.

The leaks also included the names of Palestinians who escaped the military service and did not join the PLA, and confirmed the presence of names from different ages; some of them are outside Syria, and some others are still inside, noting that dozens of Army members had fled while serving during the war years in Syria.

This comes at a time when the Syrian regime and its security forces waging a massive campaign among young people to force them to join the army, while some Palestinian refugees escaped (migrated) to outside the borders of Syria. Other refugees escaped to the inside, to areas outside the Syrian regime's control, most of the remaining Palestinian youth in Syria prefer siege, shelling, and sniping to join the military service, according to a Palestinian refugee wanted for the compulsory military service.

The AGPS documented 749 victims among the Palestinian refugees died due to gun shot, while more than 150 victims among the PLA died since the beginning of the war in Syria.

On the other hand, news from Khan Al Shieh Camp in Damascus suburb reported that a young woman was injured in the head during clashes that broke out in the vicinity of the camp near the eastern lane between affiliated gunmen for the armed opposition groups. Meanwhile, the regular army continues to target the surrounding farms with warplanes and artillery shells, which led to the destruction and devastation of homes



and casualties. The AGPS documented 166 victims who died since the beginning of war events in Syria.

The army checkpoints continue to close all roads linking the camp and the center of the capital, Damascus, and targeting the only road, that connects the camp with Zakya town, with artillery and sniper fire, which led to further deterioration of humanitarian suffering inside the camp, especially with regard to medical and living situation.

Civil Work Committees

The Charity Committee for the Relief of Palestinian People and the PRCS finished the second medical week, where institutions provide medical care through this project to the Palestinian families displaced from the Yarmouk camp to the adjacent areas.



According to those in charge of the "Medical Week," the medical staff included several medical disciplines, the most important (Heart diseases- Children-Dermatologist-Gynecologist- Public Health- Urologic.)



More than 1,000 refugees benefited from the necessary treatment and services.

The Yarmouk camp is subject to tight siege imposed by the regular army and PFGC groups, where the siege resulted in the death of more than 187 refugees due to lack of medical care and food. Humanitarian suffering exacerbated after ISIS imposed control over the camp early in April 2016

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 25\06\2016:

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1104 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1165 days, water was cut for 654 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 957 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1 149 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 810 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
