"A Bombing Targets Daraa Camp Resulted in Two Children Victims and a Number of Wounded including a Woman"



- One of Daraa Camp's Residents Died Due to Torture in the Syrian Prisons

Victims

The Palestinian refugee Omar Jum'a Rdeef from Daraa camp for Palestinian refugees died due to torture in the Syrian Regime Prisons. It is noted that AGPS documented earlier 450 Palestinian victims died due to torture in the Syrian prisons including, women, children and old people.



Recent Updates

The Syrian Regime targeted Daraa camp resulted in the death of two children; Mohamemed Qataysha and Lemar Qataysha, and five people were wounded due to targeting the camp with an explosive cylinder.



The news clarifies that the explosive cylinder targeted the northern side of the camp, which led to the collapse of a building on its residents. the local rescue teams ran evacuate the victims and wounded, where they



picked up the two children victims, who did not exceed ten years old, while five people were injured including a women with a serious injury and she is in the Nasseb town hospital. The camp and Al Sad Road neighborhood were targeted with mortar shells, and heavy guns that only led to material damages.

It is worthy to mention that 70% of Daraa camp's buildings are completely and partialy destroyed due to frequent bombing that targeted the camp with all kinds of shells and explosive barrels.

The news reported from Yarmouk Camp that Daash –ISIS- prevents dozens of families to do the power of attorney to get the financial aid of UNRWA and that there are negotiations with Dash leaders to allow them and there are no results till the moment.

Daash –ISIS- controlled the areas which were under the control of Fath Al Sham – Al Nusra Front- centered in Al Reja square and Ein Ghazzal street, and Haifa street , where more than 50 families live there in addition to the families of Fath Al Sham fighters.

The medical rescue center described the situation in Al Reja square that it is a very bad humanitarian and health situation due to the lack of food and healthy water because of the siege imposed on the area by Daash, the Syrian Regime and the regime military groups. The families in Al Reja were forced to drink the still water wells which led to the spread of some diseases such as gastroenteritis, typhoid fever, Upper respiratory tract infection, skin diseases and unexplained eruption.

This takes place amidst the continued siege by the Regular Army and PFGC for 1164 days respectively, water cut since more than 1225 days



and water cut since 741 days respectively, where the number of victims reached 187 from Yarmouk camp due to siege, hunger, and lack of medical care.

In a different context, activists and a number of residents from Khan Danoun, Al Sayeda Zainab and Jaramana camps accused associations and groups affiliated with Iran of attracting the youth and recruiting them to fight besides the Syrian regime with monthly salaries. The activist added that those groups will appear working under Palestinian names for the Palestine issue but they will fight besides the regime.

They accused local personalities in those camps of bringing the young youth to Al Husayneyyat, a place where they do religious traditions for the She'i muslims, as to recruit them to fight against the Opposition in the fronts.

The activists see that those associations and groups have increasingly gained popularity among the camps' residents coincided with the lack of financial resources, the high rate of unemployment and the bad situation, which prompted the youth to belong to them.

It is referred that many of those affiliated groups are active inside the Palestinian camps, which are still under the control of the Syrian Regime, and they recruit youth under the slogans of liberating Palestine and protecting the camps. It is noted that Al Quds brigade in Al Nairab camp in Aleppo, Al Raml camp in Lathekia, and Palestinian factions such as PFGC, Fath Al Intifada and Al Saeqa all of those mentioned groups are fighting against the Opposition and dozens of Palestinian refugees



fighting besides the regime died due to clashes against the Opposition in Syria.

Civil Work Committees

The Palestine Charity Committee continues to provide its relief and medical services to the displaced families of Yarmouk in Yelda, Bait Sahem and Bebla, where the services department provided the refugees in Yelda and Bebla with drinking water. According to a relief worker, the benefited families in June 2016 reached 820 Palestinians of Syria families. According to the Charity Committee, its Pharmacy provided more than 2063 free medical prescriptions during the past month. It is mentioned that the Palestine Charity Committee with dozens of Palestinian activists and hundreds of Yarmouk families were forced to leave the camp after the control of Daash over the camp in cooperation with Fath Al Sham-Al Nusra Front- in April 2015.





Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 25\08\2016

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid -2016*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1165 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1225 days, water was cut for 713 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1017 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1208 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 868 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
