“The Activist Ibrahim Abu Kharej Warns of the Malaysian Authorities to Deport him to Syria”



- Explosive Barrels Target the Vicinity of Khan Al Shieh Camp

Recent Updates

The activist "Ibrahim Abu-Kharej," who is detained in the Malaysian airport of Kuala Lumpur for 16 days, and on hunger strike for 8 days respectively, renewed his appeal to human rights organizations and organizations of the United Nations for urgent action to release him, warning at the same time, the intention of the Malaysian authorities to deport him to Syria or Lebanon, which could pose a threat to his life.



This comes in an appeal by Abu Kharej through Al-Quds satellite channel, where he demanded to be deported to one of the European countries, ensuring his safety, and not to be deported to Syria.

It is noteworthy that he was arrested 16 days ago by the Cambodian authorities, who deported him to Malaysia while he was trying to reach Europe.

On the other hand, at least three explosive barrels targeted the surrounding farms of Khan Al Shieh in Damascus suburb, resulting in the spread of a state of tension and anxiety among residents for fear of being bombed.



This comes in light of the closure of all major roads that link between the camp and the center of the capital Damascus by the regular army, forcing residents to go through (Zakya - Khan Al Shieh) road; the only sub-road despite risk of frequent bombardment and targeting.

The Palestinian refugee "Kamal Mahmoud Al-Mahmoud," from Hama in central Syria, was arrested on 19 September by members of Al-Furn checkpoint near Al-Asi Square. He is a bus driver, a resident of the Yarmouk refugee camp and was displaced at Al Aedein camp in Homs. He is in his forties and originally from Arab Subaih residents in Palestine.

Civil Work Committees

Palestine Charity Committee implemented a project of sacrifices at the Yarmouk camp in Damascus, where was more than (2000) shares of meat were distributed to families who were displaced to the nearby town of Yalda.

The Committee has also implemented a project of Sacrifices in Khan Al Shieh camp, and a number of Western Ghouta areas in Damascus



suburb, where (3000) shares of meat were distributed to hundreds of residents at Khan Al Shieh, Kiswa, Muqilbeia, and Zakia areas.



In a related context, the Global Relief Team in collaboration with the Charity Organization for the Relief of the Palestinian people, distributed about (3500) shares of meat to the people of the Yarmouk refugee camp who were displaced to the neighboring town of Yalda.

In addition, Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon and the Women's work Committee distributed (100) Shares of sacrificial meat on Thursday to the Palestinian Syrian families residing in the central Bekaa northern Lebanon, where the distribution included all of Jalala, Taalabaya, and Saad Nayel areas.



Numbers and Statistics till 25/9/2015:-

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- **The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 815 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 885 days, water was cut for 375 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.
- **Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 677 days respectively.
- **Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for 878 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- **Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost 523 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.

- **Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- **Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
