“Palestinian and Syrian Refugees Detained in the Macedonian Prisons Demand their Release and to Find a Solution to their Case”



- A Palestinian young man died due to torture in the Syrian prisons.
- Clashes and bombing at the Yarmouk camp led to the suspension of entering aids.
- Attempt to assassinate a leader of Aknaf Bait Al Maqdis brigades at the Yarmouk camp.
- The Syrian regime warplanes targeted the vicinity of Khan Al Sheih camp.
- Al Nairab camp in Aleppo is without water for the second day respectively.
- Severe living crises at Al Aedein camp in Homs.
- A ceremony in honor of special needs people in Jermana camp.
- A Palestinian student was arrested in the university campus in Homs.

Victims

The young man Mohammed Zaatout was killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons, raising the torture victims toll to 282 Palestinian refugees, who were documented by the AGPS. It is mentioned that the young man is from the besieged Yarmouk camp.

Macedonia

The Palestinian Syrian refugees, who are detained in the Macedonian prisons in charges of illegal entry, demanded the UN, the international and the human rights organizations to intervene for their release and to help them finding a solution to their problem in addition to allow them to immigrate to European countries. They also stressed on improving their living situation inside "Ghazi Baba" camp.

Meanwhile, about 350 Palestinian and Syrian youth, who are detained in the Macedonian prisons, announced their hunger strike on 22nd of December 2014, protesting on their detention in hard conditions, since the Macedonian prisons lack to the minimum level of hygiene and healthy food. In addition to the narrow spaces where they detained in large numbers, they also demanded to release them and allow them to complete their way to Europe. It is referred that Macedonia is one of the points that passes by runaway refugees from the war in Syria to Europe.

The detained refugees appealed all human rights organizations to intervene urgently and immediately to release them and end their suffering.



Recent Updates

Bombing targeted the Yarmouk camp south of Damascus and resulted in big destruction in the buildings and properties, coincided with violent clashes broke out between the armed Syrian opposition and the regular army alongside with Palestinian factions loyal to it, which is centering outside the camp, resulted in the suspension of food and health aids provided by UNRWA to the residents of the Yarmouk camp for the 3rd week respectively.

Meanwhile, our correspondent reported news about an attempt to assassinate "Abu HammamNidal" a leader of Aknaf Bait Al MAqdis brigades, as he was targeted with an explosive bomb was placed in front of his house by unknown armed group who escaped. The attempt resulted in the injury of Abu Hammam and one of his body guards.

For his part, the General Manager of the Palestinian Arab Refugees Committee in Damascus "Ali Mustafa Ali" confirmed that the armed groups inside the Yarmouk camp prevented the distribution of aids to the residents and accused them of assassinating those who work in the relief sector to prevent them of doing their humanitarian tasks. Mr. Ali also demand them to leave the camp so the residents can come back to their houses, while the regular army and groups of the PFGC are imposing siege on the Yarmouk camp for 537 days respectively.

In the same context, warplanes hovered above Khan Al Sheih camp, while the surrounding farms and areas were targeted with explosive barrels



which caused a state of fear among the residents, who are complaining of hard living conditions due to the ongoing war in Syria and the closure of Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road, the only road that link the camp with Damascus city.

Our correspondent confirmed that the power is still cut at Al Nairab camp in Aleppo for the second day respectively due to the stop of the thermal station, while the residents are still complaining of the state of unsecure and instability due to the deteriorating security situation in the surrounding areas and due to the involvement of some civilians in the fighting beside the Syrian army, which made the camp subjected to bombing that led to many injuries and victims.

Al Aedein camp in Homs is suffering of many living crises, most important is the lack of food and the scarcity of fuel, as the residents are complaining of the repeated power cut with an amount of 15 hours cut per day. In addition to the suffering of heating with Gas and firewood, since its prices have raised tripled due to the merchants monopoly, in a time that the residents are facing great difficulties in finding job and finding a source of living in order to secure all this expenses, which the Syrian regular army checkpoints allow to alleviate it in condition of payment.

Detainees

The university student "Mohammed Ahmed Qassad" was arrested after the Syrian security forces raided the university campus on 16-12-2014, as they arrest the young man and led him to unknown destination. It is worth mentioning that the young man is in his twenties, originally from Safad city in Palestine.

Civil Work Committees

Civil Development Center in Jermana camp held a ceremony in honor of the special needs people, as the ceremony included a theater performance – a song titled " A rose of Hope", while some presents were introduced to the special needs people at the end of the ceremony.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 25/12/2014

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *2589 Palestinian refugees were documented by the AGPS including 157 women, 280 were killed due to torture, 268 were killed by sniper shot, 84 refugees were field executed, and 984 refugees were killed due to bombing.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 538 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 619 days, water was cut for 108 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.*
- *80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 14348 refugees in Jordan, 42,000 in Lebanon, according to UNRWA statistics till November 2014.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 440days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 410days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 611 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 255 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al AedeinCamps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.*
