Victims

A number of former detainees in the Syrian regime's prisons confirmed that four Palestinian refugees died under torture in the Syrian prisons.

The Documentation Center for Palestinian Detainees and Missing People in Syria received a list of names for the refugees and their specifications by detainees were released, they were witnesses to their deaths in the Syrian security branches.



The victims are:

The Palestinian Syrian youth "Bilal" from (Damascus suburb - Sasa), the oldest of his brothers; he is married and has two children, died under torture in Palestine Branch235, an elderly Palestinian Syrian, aged approximately 60 years from Yarmouk and was arrested after he fled from the Yarmouk refugee camp in (Damascus - Almaydan), diabetic, works in Milk and cheeses factory, died in Palestine Branch235, the Palestinian Syrian youth "Abu Rashid" nearly 30 years; he is married and has two children, he died under torture at the Palestine Branch 235, and "Salah al-Ahmad" Palestinian Syrian, aged approximately 40 years, died under torture in Fayhaa branch.



It is noteworthy that the AGPS documented 427 victims who died due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime, while 1016 is still detained in the prisons of the Syrian regime and their fate is unknown.

Recent Updates

Activists and a number of residents from Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb called the camp's residents, through Facebook pages, to take caution when crossing Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road, due to the targeting of this road with heavy weapons from the regular army sites.

Zakya - Khan Al Shieh is the only way that feeds the camp while all other road are still closed, forcing residents to go through that way in spite of the danger of always being targeted by the Syrian army, which led to many victims.



In a related context, Syrian regime forces arrested the injured refugee Walied Abu Raya in the town of Al Kiswa in Damascus suburb.

He was arrested from the hospital and he has a serious health condition after being injured the day before yesterday by the Syrian army shelling



that targeted the vicinity of Khan Al Shieh camp. He is a volunteer in the team of reforming electricity in the camp.

In the Yarmouk camp in Damascus, vaccines campaign against polio started in Palestine hospital, and it is scheduled to include about a thousand children under five years old.

The campaign begun after the security forces and the Syrian army allowed UNRWA to enter a quantity of vaccines against Polio, which, in turn, provide vaccines for the Palestinian Red Crescent Society in the camp.



It is worth mentioning that the Yarmouk camp is suffering from an acute shortage of all medical and emergency materials because of the continued siege imposed by the regular army and PFGC groups for (878) days respectively.

Action Group for Palestinians of Syria

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team called families of victims, detainees, and missed people from the Palestinians of Syria to document their information at the AGPS website.

The information will be added at the documented statistics that are translated and distributed to the concerned international human rights bodies and organizations.



It is worth mentioning that the AGPS documented (3073) victims, (1016) detainees, and (280) missed people from the Palestinian refugees in Syria.

Numbers and Statistics till 26/11/2015

- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 878 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 948 days, water was cut for 438 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 739 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 940 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 584 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
