### **Recent Updates**

*Action Group for Palestinians of Syria received some photos that show the trespasses of Syrian opposition members against women at the Yarmouk camp. The photos show members of Free Army bother women in the camp during the organization of lines to get aid. As the picture shows one of the members while he was trying to hit one of the women on her face, this was not possible for the group to make sure of the authenticity of the picture from another source.*

*On the other hand, the distribution of aid quantities resumed to the Yarmouk refugees camp that have been trapped for more than 11 months.*

*The Khan Al Shaih refugees in Damascus heard sounds of violent explosions around them. The sounds were heavy shelling targeted the areas surrounding the camp, coincided with the warplanes overhead, causing the spread of a state of tension amongst people.*



*The repeated shelling at neighboring areas led to the interruption of the roads which connects the camp and the city center, causing the loss of many medical and food supplies from the camp. The people of the camp are suffering from deterioration of health services due to the stop of all hospitals in the camp while the UNRWA's clinic works in a minimum capacity as a result of the shortage of materials and medical staff.*

### ***The Action Group for Palestinians of Syria issued its Weekly Report***

*The Action Group announced in its weekly report that was published yesterday that 6 Palestinians were killed last week. The report closely monitored the continuation of bombings on more than one camp. The Daraa camp was targeted with Shelling and bombing and the handarat camp was targeted with explosive barrels more than once.*

*Some missiles were fallen on the Reja space yard in the Yarmouk camp that led to stop the aid distribution. In addition to the clashes between the Regular Army with the Popular Front General Command and the Free army in the Palestine street at the Yarmouk Camp. The Main street of Khan al Shaih in Damascus witnessed clashes between the Regular Army and the Opposition members.*
