Recent Updates

The AGPS correspondent in Hama reported that the Syrian Security detained three women with their children from Yarmouk camp, while they were returning back from the Turkish borders after they failed crossing to Turkey though their many trials which last to 20 days. It is mentioned that the detention of the women was near the Political Security checkpoint in Hama, names were not announced because of some reasons related to the detained women.



The vicinity of Al Nairab camp in Aleppo was exposed to bombing with mortar shells, where a shell was fallen behind the Culture Center, which was changed to be a hospital, and the other shell was fallen near the entrance of the camp and the third shell was fallen on an agricultural land, where damage was limited to only materials. It is mentioned that Al Nairab camp is completely controlled by the Regular Army and the Palestinian factions loyal to the Army and the camp is also considered from the strategic areas in Aleppo city because it is surrounded by Al Nairab civil and military airports.



On the other hand, the residents of Al Raml camp at lathekia complain from the continuous raids and arrest campaigns, where the Syrian Security forces inspect the houses of the camp once in a while which increases the suffering of the residents. Moreover, the Palestinian factions loyal to the Army raid the houses of the camp and take them as headquarters. The youth of the camp suffer from being chased by the Syrian Security forces to oblige them to join the compulsory military services at the PLA, which led most of them to escape out of Syria. The residents of Al Raml camp live in a quite situation amid the continuous increase in their economic burdens where they complain the high prices of food materials in addition to the high rate of rent houses.



In the same context, hundreds of Palestinian families, who were displaced from their camps due to siege and bombing to Al Dakhaneyya Area, Al Kabas Area and Dwela East of Damascus, suffer from the spread of unemployment and the high prices of rent houses led them not to find houses easily in addition to many conditions imposed by the owners of the houses in those towns. The families appealed UNRWA, the PLO, and the



Palestinian Factions to hold responsibilities towards them and work to return them back to their camps that they were displaced from such as Al Husaineyya and Al Sbeina camps and Yarmouk camps.

It is mentioned that a big number of Palestinian families were obliged to leave on 12-09-2014 after the invasion of the Opposition forces to Al Dakhaneyya area and their control over close neighborhoods from Jaramana, Ein Terma and Al Kbas.

In Gaza Strip, after the Palestinians of Syria escaped from the ongoing war in Syria, they face the harsh and cruel life in Gaza where they suffer from miserable economic conditions in addition to inability to secure housing and employment, and that because the catastrophic situation in Gaza Strip as a result of the last Israeli war on Gaza and the siege that Israel imposes on Gaza many years ago. Families complained UNRWA and PLO and Palestinian parties' negligence toward them.



Palestinian of Syria in Gaza appealed the Government, PLO and International Institutions to take its role in protecting refugees of the



Arab Countries and to meet their basic needs and work on the financial dues assessed by the Council of Ministers dated 04.06.2015 Exchange.

Hundreds of Palestinian-Syrian families returned to the Gaza Strip after they arrived to Egypt since more than 2 years ago.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 27/04/2016:

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015*
- *8000 Palestinians of Syria Refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinians of Syria Refugees are in Gaza Strip*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1047 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1108 days, water was cut for 597 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 186.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 902days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1095 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 755 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
