"A Palestinian Child Dies Due to Shelling by the Regular Army at Khan Al Shieh Camp"



- A Palestinian Refugee Died during the Ongoing Clashes in Yarmouk, Damascus

Victims

Two Palestinian refugees died due to the ongoing conflict in Syria, including the child "Ahmed Zuhair Teheimar," who died due to the shelling that targeted different areas at Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb.



Meanwhile, the young man, Mustafa Abbas, died during the repeated clashes between ISIS and Nusra in the Yarmouk camp, which is lasting since April 2016.

Recent Updates

The Syrian regime targeted Khan Al Shieh camp yesterday with tank shells and resulted in the death of the Palestinian child, Ahmed Zuhair Teheimar, in addition to damages at civilian houses, as it resulted in a





state of panic among residents.

The shelling coincided with heavy bombardment by the Syrian Regular Army warplanes which targeted the adjacent towns, farms, Al Deirhabeya area, and Al Abaseia farms with at least 25 explosive barrels.

Meanwhile, violent clashes broke out in the adjacent areas, while the Syrian armed opposition factions launched the operation of "Freedom Fighters to Break the Siege." The operation came in an attempt to alleviate the siege imposed over the region.

It is worth mentioning that Khan Al Shieh camp is besieged after the regular army checkpoints closed all roads linking the camp with the center of the capital Damascus, which resulted in aggravated humanitarian suffering.

Violent clashes broke out between ISIS and Nusra in the Yarmouk camp south of Damascus, after ISIS tried to break into areas controlled by Nusra at Jauna neighborhood east of the camp.

The storming of Ja'una area is the fifth of its kind during one week, according to activists from the camp, where the region has seen vigorous attempts by ISIS to take control of the neighborhood, and in return members of Nusra managed to restore two buildings were under the control of ISIS.

Activists confirmed that Nusra fighters used medium machine guns of 14.5 mm for the first time during the clashes, which means, according to activists, more devastation and destruction of besieged and displaced



people's homes, in addition to targeting the houses with grenades and firebombs in an attempt from both sides to earn zones and control them away from sniper fire.



In southern Syria, the regular army targeted houses of Palestinian refugee in Deraa camp with Anti-aircraft, which resulted in a state of panic and fear among residents, especially children. Members of the Syrian army and security at Al Mahkama Al JAdeeda checkpoint opened random against civilians, with no reports of casualties.

People of the camp are still suffering due to the absence of health and relief services, where they did not receive any aid for more than two years, as people have been suffering from the water cut since April 2014.





Release

The Syrian security forces released the Palestinian refugee, Ubada Kanani, from Deraa camp, after being detained for more than 3 years. Meanwhile, the Syrian security services continue to detain more than 1500 Palestinian refugees, including 1076 detainees, including women, children and old people, were documented by the AGPS.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 27\05\2016:

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1077 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1138 days, water was cut for 627 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 931 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1 122 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 784 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
