“70% of Dara'a Houses were Destroyed....the Yarmouk Camp without Water for 80 days”



Dara'a camp

- The Action Group: - 16 victims from Khan Danoun camp since the beginning of the events in Syria.
- Bombing on the vicinity of Khan Al Sheih camp that caused a worry and tension state amongst the residents.
- Jermana camp residents suffer of high living cost and unemployment.
- Wood is the first method of heating in the Palestinian Refugees camps in Syria.
- The Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon organized a course for its volunteers in the documentation field.
- Distributing heaters and wood on the Palestinians of Syria families in Kilis city in Turkey.

Statistics

The Monitoring and Documentation Team of the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria announced that the number of victims from the residents of Khan Danoun camp in Damascus Suburb since the beginning of the events in Syria, has reached 16 victims, including 6 were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons, 3 were killed during the bombing, a victim was killed due to sniper's shot, 3 victims due to gunshot, two victims due to burn and a refugee victim from the camp died due to unknown reasons.

Recent Updates

The continuation of bombing and frequent clashes on Dar'aa camp during the last months has led to damaging 70% of its houses, according to unofficial assessments. The Dar'aa camp's residents are suffering from the absence of most of the basic services such as water, electricity and medical care in addition to the weakness of the relief agencies work in their areas, where UNRWA distributes financial aids through money exchange shops which are always far from the camp, which promotes the residents to risk their lives through passing many of dangerous clashes areas to reach those centers. It is mentioned that all these obstacles have led the residents, of the surrounding areas, to leave to other towns and villages.

In the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees, the checkpoints of the Regular Army and the groups of the PFGC, which are imposing a strict siege on the Yarmouk camp for about 510 days, allowed the entry of limited quantities of food aids that were distributed on the besieged residents, they also allowed for a number of families, who left the camp, to return back. It is referred that the water cut continues for 80 days respectively.

In Damascus Suburb, Khan Al Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees witnessed a calm and carefulness state through the warplanes hovering over the camp, coincided with voices of separate clashes in the surrounding farms and areas. The residents of the camp are suffering of the continuation of the security situation tensions in the surrounding



areas that led the camp to be exposed to bombing with shells and explosive barrels that resulted in some victims and wounded.

The Residents of the besieged Yarmouk camp , Dar'aa camp, Khan Al Sheih camp and Khan Danoun camp are suffering of a severe crises in securing the fuel of heating where they are forced to use wood for warming instead of heaters that use fuel or electricity ,which became rare in the camps, because of the siege that is imposed on some of them like Al Yarmouk camp or the unavailability like Khan Danoun camp or because of the roads closure and clashes in the surrounding areas like in Khan Danoun and Khan Al Sheih camps. In general, all the Palestinian camps in Syria are suffering of tight crisis in fuel and electricity which led them to return back to the old ways of heating.

In the same context, the residents of Jermana camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus Suburb and the displaced refugees from the other camps and areas that witness clashes and siege are complaining of the high prices of rent houses specially with the increasing of the demand. The families became sharing the same houses as a trial to alleviate the economic burdens moreover the unemployment came to increase these burdens where most of the refugees depend on the aids that the relief organization distribute which don't cover the living expenses in light of the high prices.

Lebanon

The Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon in cooperation with the National Project to maintain the roots of the Palestinian family "Haweyya" have organized a training course to their volunteers in the field of documentation for the Palestinian family on Sunday 23rd of November 2014 in Haweyya center. It is mentioned that the course contains three lectures and a workshop and discussed the importance of documentation for the Palestinian towns and families in order to confront the Zionism project in addition to the documentations mechanisms and research for families information, moreover they had some practical training on family tree information collection, analysis and documentation.



Turkey

The Public Commission for the Palestinian Refugees of the Temporary Syrian Government, through its project of "Together we reach them", distributed heaters and wood on the displaced Palestinians of Syria families in Kilis city in Turkey. It is worth mentioning that the number of the beneficiaries of this project is 137 families in addition to the families in the temporary shelter center, where big heaters were installed inside the center.

Civil Work Committees

The Department of Services at the Palestine Charity Commission installed heaters in the rooms of Al Jarmak Alternative School in the Yarmouk camp to secure a suitable education atmosphere for the students in order to be safe from the diseases in the winter season.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 27/11/2014

- *The number of Palestinian refugee victims in Syria has reached 2558.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 510 days respectively. In addition, power cuts*

continued for more than 593 days, water was cut for 80 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.

- *41 Palestinian refugees were killed outside of Syria.*
- *96 PLA members were killed due to Clashes in Syria.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 412 days respectively.*
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 382 days respectively.*
- ***Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for 582 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- ***Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost 227 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.*
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.*
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:** - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.*
- ***Al Nairab Camp:** - Power is still cut for more than a year.*
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.*
