### ***Victims***

*The Palestinians refugee, Qasim Awad, from the Yarmouk camp in Damascus, died due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime, raising the number of Palestinian refugees who died due to torture in Syria to 426 victims.*



### ***Recent Updates***

*Four Afghani refugee children died following the sinking of their boat off the Turkish coast. According to the Anatolia agency, the boat was carrying 55 migrants from Syria - Palestinian Syrian refugees are likely to be among them - and Afghanistan, where their boat sank while trying to reach the Greek Island (Lesbos).*

*In the same context, Anatolia agency confirmed that the Turkish Coast Guard was able to rescue 357 refugees from drowning during the last 24 hours.*

*It is worth mentioning that the Turkish coast is the starting point for hundreds of boats carrying refugees fleeing from the war in Syria to Europe.*



*On the other hand, services team of Palestine Charity Committee continues to provide relief services to the displaced people of Yarmouk at the neighboring towns, where the body provides some material assistance, as well as to provide drinking water for the residents.*

*It is noteworthy that thousands of displaced people in the Yarmouk refugee camp have fled to neighboring towns, following the storming of ISIS last April.*

*184 refugees from the camp have died due to the strict siege imposed by the regular army and PFGC groups about three years ago.*



*In Lebanon, Al Wafaa European campaign, in cooperation with Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon, distributed fuel to the*



*Palestinian Syrian families displaced in the western Beqaa Baalbek on Thursday 26/11.*

*The fuel distribution came as a part of a series of convoys of Al Wafaa European campaign European for the relief of refugee before the winter, while the Delegation of al Wafaa campaign implemented a field tour to families in accommodation, in order to see their living conditions and to hear their complaints and their pain and needs.*



*On the other hand, "the Union of Islamic institutions for the relief of displaced persons from Syria" announced a new census of displaced Palestinian Syrians and Syrians at Ein Al Hilwa camp.*

*According to the Union, the statistics will begin next Monday in November 30 and will continue until 26 December as part of a comprehensive survey of all Palestinian refugee camps in Lebanon.*

*It is noteworthy that the number of Palestinian Syrian families inside Ein Al Hilwa camp in Sidon, southern Lebanon is 1400 families.*





***Numbers and Statistics till 27/11/2015:-***

- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 879 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 949 days, water was cut for 439 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 740 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 941 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 585 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
