Recent Updates

The AGPS documented the names of 9 victims of Palestinian refugees who died after a violent battle that is raging in the Syrian south several days ago.

Artillery and aerial bombing that targeted both Daraa camp and Muzareeb compound, in addition to the clashes that broke out between the Syrian armed opposition and the regular army battalions, has led to the death of at least 9 refugees; they are:

"Ali Qwaider" also known as Abu Hussein and "Mahmoud Bitari" who died after heavy shelling that targeted Muzareeb town last Thursday, while each of "Khaled Nassar," "Aqab Nassar," "Mohammed Fallaha," and "Basil Habib" died as a result of clashes with Syrian regular army at Al Mansheia front.



Meanwhile, "Khaled Ibrahim Bakr," and the girl "Elaf Yasin Abu Jaas" also died due to the shelling of the regular army on Al Sahari neighborhood.



"Kamal Mohamed Abdel Kader" died following the bombing of Al Naema town with explosive container before yesterday.



It is worth mentioning that the southern region in Syria are experiencing the heaviest fighting in months, between the Syrian armed opposition and the regular army battalions in a battle named by the opposition as "south storm."

The opposition army used medium weapons, while the army used artillery and warplanes to repel the opposition attacks on the army's controlled areas.

In a related context, Syrian warplanes targeted Muzareeb town with a missile that hit one of its homes, injuring a number of children and women, where our correspondent confirmed that about 15 children and women from the Palestinian family of Al Qaraqty were wounded in the raid. The 15 injuries are displaced from Daraa camp to Muzareeb compound, as residents suffered of a state of fear and panic because of the raid and fear of being repeated.



In Damascus, violent explosions rocked Khan Al Shieh camp before Al Maghreb Azan yesterday, as our correspondent reported that warplanes dropped a number of explosive barrels on the surrounding farms which resulted in a panic state among residents.

It is noteworthy that the camp was repeatedly bombed with explosive barrels over the past few weeks, which led to victims and a number of wounded, in addition to the massive destruction of properties.

Release

Syrian security forces released the Palestinian Syrian refugee woman "Doaa Agag," 22 years, after being detained for nearly three months, and had been arrested from the distribution point of food aid in the Yarmouk camp.

It is noteworthy that the AGPS documented the names of 41 Palestinian refugee detained in Syrian prisons, while the total number of Palestinian detainees, since the start of the war events, has reached 901 Palestinian prisoners; their fate is unknown yet.

Arrest

Syrian security forces raided the house of the refugee "Mohammed Ismail Omar" yesterday and arrested after he turned himself following the security members detained his brother as a hostage to put pressure on him to turn himself in after he escaped from them. It was mentioned that "Omar" is in his twenties, originally from Al Shajara village in Palestine.



Syrian security arrested "Tariq Hassan Bassiouni," a member of security committees of the regime after he refused to go to fight alongside the Syrian army on a raging front in Aleppo. It is referred that "Bassiouni" is in the end of his thirties, originally Haifa city in Palestine.

Civil Work Committees

Palestine Charity Committee and its cadres in Muzareeb town continue ambulance operations where they transfer the wounded to Muzareeb Martyrs hospital.



It is referred that Muzareeb town includes a gathering of Palestinian refugees estimated to 8,500 Palestinian refugees who suffer from lack of food, medical supplies, and medicines because the regime's blockade on the region.



In Turkey, several charitable bodies contribute helping Palestinian Syrian refugees in Turkey and in several areas, where Palestinians of Syria Committee in Turkey distributed food baskets provided by Alekhaainsany Association to the Palestinian Syrian families in the cities of Qrkhan, Lhasa, and Islaheia, where the number of families in this areas is 18 families.

In the city of Kilis, Palestinians of Syria Committee distributed Ramadan basket provided by Al Wafaa European campaign and Palestine Scholars abroad to the Palestinian families in the city of Kilis, which numbered 160 families.

The Committee also distributed food rations in the city of Mrash provided by Palestine Scholars abroad and Al Wafaa European campaign, where The number of Palestinian refugees in the city Mrash is 20 Palestinian families.

It is noteworthy that the number of Palestinian refugees from Syria who reside in Turkey is around 4,000 according to unofficial statistics, as they had fled from their camps because of the continued war in Syria.

Numbers and Statistics till 26/6/2015

- 80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*



- *The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 901 detainees, and 398 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 730 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 800 days, water was cut for 290 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 611 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 592 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 794 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 437 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
