"Catastrophe in Austria Causes the Death of Dozens of Refugees in a Truck"

Recent Updates

Austrian police discovered, yesterday morning, a truck containing bodies of dozens of migrants, who are suspected to be Syrians and died strangled in a truck was found parked on the highway in the province of Burgenland, near Hungary border.

For their part, the Austrian Ministries of Interior and Justice announced yesterday afternoon that the number of victims ranges between twenty and fifty victims, while they carried smugglers responsibility for this incident.

Sources confirmed to the AGPS that the Austrian authorities dealing with the incident gives the impression of willingness to block any criticism of receiving refugees policy, which force them to this grave risks.

The sources also confirmed that the Austrian authorities did not open the car yet, and there is no information about names, numbers, or nationalities of victims, adding that the bodies had decomposed



significantly due to the total closure of the truck in addition to climatic factors.

In the same context, the Italian Coast Guard said it found, on Wednesday, the bodies of 50 people were on board a boat carrying migrants off the Libyan coast.

The spokesman for the Italian troops informed Reuters News Agency that 430 people on board the boat were rescued.

According to the BBC's Arabic site, spokeswoman of the Italian coast guard forces said that the rescue operation, which was carried out by the Swedish ship, is one within 10 operations carried out in the water off Libya.



The Italian Navy did not disclose the nationalities or ages of the victims.

In Damascus Suburb, Al Tiba town, which is adjacent to Khan Danoun camp, was exposed to bombing that was heard clearly in the camp. It is mentioned that the adjacent town to the camp witnesses separate clashes between the Regular Army and the Opposition forces during the last period.



The residents also complain the high living costs and the high prices of food materials in addition to the high rent costs inside the camp due to the big displacement wave to the camp from the other camps, who were obliged to leave due to bombing and siege.

In south of Syria at Der'aa governorate in general and in Der'aa camp and Al Muzareeb compound in particular, the Palestinian refugees suffer of a complete absence for the necessities of life, where the water and power cut by the Syrian regime continues for about 493 days.

The residents get water from so far places and they pay to buy fuel in order to operate the power generators, moreover, the residents suffer of other crises like the wheat material, which is under the allowance of the Jordanian authorities to enter to the Opposition areas.

Release

The Syrian Security released the refugee Mhmoud Darwish Ibrahim Shloun two days ago after being arrested for about 18 days. It is referred



that he is in the forties and from Acre city in Palestine. It is worthy to mention that the AGPS documented those 960 Palestinian detainees in the Syrian Prisons.

Civil Work Committees

The displaced residents of Khan Al Shieh camp at Jaddedat Artouz area carried out students activities at Hussine Eid School like folklore shows for children.

On the other hand, Jafra organization at Jaramana camp in Damascus Suburb carried out theatre and folklore shows for the children of Jafra center.

It is referred that the children and teens of the Palestinian camps were exposed to serious violations such as detention, hunger, lack of medical care, bombing, and sniping in addition to the stop of the education process for lots of children of the Palestinian camps specially the besieged camps.



The children also suffer of the instability due to leaving from place to place, which negatively affected the residents in general and the children in particular in tragic psychological situations.

Numbers and Statistics till 27/8/2015

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 786 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 856 days, water was cut for 346 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 180 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 648 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 849 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 493 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
