"Activists Warn Families of PS Arrestees from Scams and Blackmail Incidents"

RECENT UPDATES

Activists strongly warned the families of Palestinian-Syrian detainees in prisons, of scams and possible blackmail incidents carried out by mediators and lawyers for revealing the fate or place of detention of their family members.

Many families were subjected to frauds and blackmailing, activists confirm, asked for huge amounts of money for false promises of release, amounts could be from \$2,000 up to \$20,000 for each case, depending on the nature of charges of the arrestee.



It is noteworthy that the AGPS managed to document 1048 PS detainees unaccounted for in prisons of Assad's regime, and 431 others were tortured to death in such places.

In a different topic, Khan Eshieh Camp and its vicinity were exposed to mortar shelling and warplanes raids. Three mortar shells were fired from Syrian Army's points at Al-Kabousiyya hill towards Al-Zuhoor Street and Nestle Street crossroads caused a tension status among civilians with no



reports of injuries. Meanwhile airplanes targeted the farms around the camp at Al-Abbasa area, Al-Saeed Street and Al-Salam motorway.

It should be noted that Al-Kabousiyya hill represents a "nightmare" to civilians as the camp had been exposed to several damages and repetitive shelling because of this regime's artillery.

People of Khan Eshieh camp suffer from the continuing targeting of the last open road by artillery and sniper shots which led to the shortage of medical supplies and basic goods inside the camp.



NGOs

In Turkey, Bulbul Zade Association in cooperation with Palestinians-in-Turkey Committee has visited the most needy PS families in Kilis Town south of Turkey, where they provided them food parcels and financial support. Whereas the committee briefed the difficulties of PS families and suffering in general, and inability to get in and out the country in legal ways, and the educational troubles and leakage due to high costs in particular.



The latest unofficial statistics indicated that PS in Turkey census estimated at 6,000 to 8,000 refugees across the country, according to the Semi-Annual report of the AGPS.



Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 27 January 2016

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 42,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command), continued for 957 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1019 days, water cut for 507 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 185 victims .*

- *Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 813 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1006 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 667 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL-SaiedaZainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.*
