“Three Palestinians Killed in Syria and Violent Clashes in the Vicinity of Al Nairab Camp”



- Residents of Khan Al Sheih camp confirm to the Action Group that there are no armed people in their camp.
- Eleven Civil institutions and committees in Yarmouk camp demand to treat the humanitarian problems as soon as possible.
- Yarmouk Local Council put the moral responsibility of the siege on the United Nations.
- The General Assembly of the Palestinian refugee's affairs in the Syrian Temporary Government takes care of Rakan Hussein's family until they reunite with him.

Victims

Three Palestinians were killed in Syria, they are:

- *"Amer Khalid Darweish" from AL Aedein camp in Homs who was killed in unknown circumstances, as there was no information about him since almost a year in the place of his work at Al Moshaa School in Aleppo.*

- *"Mohammed Jamal Maweid" 19 years, from Yarmouk camp, Safouria street, passed away due to a liver disease and sunstroke during performing compulsory military service of Palestinian Liberation Army. Mohammed was detained in the prisons of Syrian Regime since almost a year.*

- *"Imad Ahmed Thiab" 27 years, was killed while he was trying to remove a bomb remnants in Dara'a city, as the bomb exploded and hit him and his serious injury killed him.*

Recent Updates

Violent clashes broke out between Syrian Regular Army and groups of Free Army near Aleppo international Airport which is close to the Nairab camp in Aleppo. They used heavy and medium weapons. Al NAirab camp is under the control of the Syrian Regular Army.

A state of calm and anxiety prevailed on Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city after being targeted yesterday with two explosive barrels resulted in one victim and a number of critical case injuries.

Mohammed is one of the camps residents, expressed to the Group correspondent, his wondering about targeting the camp with explosive barrels, where he assure that the camp is totally empty of any armed.

Residents of Khana AL Sheih camp refuse to be involve at this conflict expressing their neutrality, while Mohammed confirmed that the people live in a difficult condition and they suffer of a severe shortage in food supplies and public services inside the camp.

On the other hand, eleven civil institutions and committees in Yarmouk camp issued a joint statement, appeals all parties for an immediate action to treat humanitarian sides in Yarmouk camp, especially in the holy month of Ramadan. They also demanded to open the road in and out of the camp, introducing food and medical aid and to work on returning back the public services particularly the drinking water.

Thus, Yarmouk Civic Council sent a statement explaining that engineers, Solicitors and intellectuals put the moral responsibility on the UN General Secretary "Ban KI Moon" of protecting Palestinian refugees who were besieged for more than a year.

The statement also put the full moral responsibility of the residents suffering on the Senior United Nations officials in Syria, as they were not having responsibility, referring to the party that obstruct the implementation of UN decision(2139) about humanitarian aid, according to the statement.



The statement also demanded all parts that obstruct the implementation of the UN resolution "2139" on humanitarian aid, according to the statement, the statement called on all conferees to respect the international humanitarian law and neutralize the civilians and not to use them as a card for political gains.

Civil Work Committees

Palestine Charity Committee, the institutions and assemblies in Yarmouk camp continue to the project "Iftar Sa'em", Which is Feeding the Fast People project, in an attempt to alleviate residents suffering. The Committee prepares and distributes 31 meals to the old people and special needs who cannot find a provider.

In the same context, General Assembly for Palestinian refugees affairs of the Syrian Temporary Government, announced that it will provide all expenses of Rakan Hussein's family in Turkey.

The Assembly will provide them residency, food and clothes until their case is solved and reunited with their father. Rakan went on hunger strike in Hungary protesting at the Hungarian authorities decisions about not granting his family the visa under the pretext of not recognizing their Palestinian Syrian passports.
