“The Action Group: 984 Palestinian Syrian Refugees were killed in the Yarmouk Camp till Yesterday”



Yarmouk camp

- Heavy shelling targets Daraa Camp.
- The Yarmouk Camp without water for 51 days respectively.
- Violent clashes continue in the vicinity of Handarat Camp in Aleppo.
- The power is back to Khan AL Sheih Camp in Damascus city.
- Italian Police arrested Palestinian Syrian refugees including children.
- Legal and economic crises faced by the Palestinians of Syria in Egypt.
- Relief agencies continue providing its services in the Yarmouk Camp.

Statistics

The documentary and statistics team of the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria confirmed that they documented 948 Palestinian Syrian victims were killed in the Yarmouk Camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus. 155 of them were killed due to the strict siege that imposed by the Syrian Army and groups of the PFGC, while the Action Group pointed out that the total number of Palestinian victims, who were documented, is 2532.

Recent Updates

Heavy shelling targeted Daraa Camp for Palestinian refugees southern Syria with heavy artillery shells targeted different areas, while our correspondent could not know about any injuries, as unofficial statistics confirmed that 70 % of the camps' houses were destroyed due to the repeated bombing during the last few months.

In Damascus, the water cut in the Yarmouk Camp continues for 51 days respectively in light of the strict siege since 481 days, as the residents are suffering of the aggravate of living crises, while most prominent one is the loss of food and medical supplies which is aggravated with water and power cut.

On the other hand, violent clashes broke out in the vicinity of Handarat Camp for Palestinian refugees in Aleppo between the Regular Army and groups of the Syrian opposition, as the Regular Army seeks to enter the areas that are controlled by the opposition including Handarat Camp which is exposed the frequent bombing once in a while.

In another context, the power returned back to the houses of Khan AL Sheih Camp in Damascus city after cut for a whole day, while the roads which are linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for "Zakih- Khan Al Shieh" where it impacts negatively on the availability of food supplies in the camp markets.

As in Italy, Italian police arrested, yesterday, "21" Palestinian and Syrian refugees, who arrived the Italian territory through a truck that was carrying "33" immigrants from Greece, and according to what was said by the Italian police that the refugees were facing hard times because of



their status in the truck fund without good ventilation and without water and food. It is mentioned that hundreds of Palestinian Syrian families were forced to illegally immigrate by riding "Death boats" in an effort to reach Europe escaping of the ongoing war in Syria.



Turning to Egypt, where the rest of the Palestinian Syrian refugees are living under unclear legal situation in conjunction with the political and security tensions in the country, as the Egyptian Security refuses to give the Palestinian Syrian refugees any residency despite that they met the formal requirements for the issuance of those residencies.

The permanent pretext, according to many refugees who met our correspondent, is that security approvals have not yet reached," while their suffering increased after the rise in prices witnessed in the country in recent months, in addition to the lack of employment opportunities.

Therefore, those circumstances forced hundreds of them to risk and ride boats of death to reach Europe asking for a dignified life and stability, which lost in Egypt, and is noteworthy that Egypt currently prevent the entry of Palestinian Syrian refugees into its territory.

Civil Work Committees

Relief Agencies in the Yarmouk Camp continue to provide its services to the residents; those services included securing an amount of drinking



water for the residents of the camp who suffer from continuous water cut about two months ago. The agencies perform several campaigns to clean up the streets of the camp and lift the rubble, while the service department in Palestine Charity Committee clean sewage emollients, while they managed to repair the sewage line pipes in order to prevent the dirty water accumulation, which cause the spread of odor, germs, and diseases among the residents of that region.



The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics:

- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - The Continuance of the siege which is imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC for **481** days respectively in addition to the power cut for more than **564** days and the water cut for **51** days respectively. The number of the siege victims is **155** victims.
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **383** days respectively.
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **352** days respectively.
- ***Handarat Camp:***-The residents left the camp since **552** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - Almost **198** days without water and a complete absence of basic services.



- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - the roads that linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for the Zakia road.
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:*** - economic crisis is still continue, specially the unemployment and the high prices.
- ***Al Nairab Camp:*** - the power is still cut for more than a year.
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - relative calm situation in light of the economic crises.
