- Unknown groups assassinate a Palestinian refugee from the Yarmouk camp in Damascus.
- A Palestinian refugee, at least, was killed in a car accident in the desert of Sudan.
- Two members of Al-Quds Brigade were killed due to clashes in the vicinity Handarat camp.
- Action Group: "188" refugees were killed in Daraa camp during the war in Syria.
- Relief entities in Yarmouk are working to mitigate the effects of water cuts from the camp.
- Palestinian refugees in Cyber City in Jordan appeal to improve their situations.

Action Group for Palestinians of Syria

In conjunction with the International Day for Solidarity with the Palestinian People, the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria issued a press release calling all public and private international, Arab and Palestinian institutions and organizations for urgent action to put an end to the suffering of Palestinian refugees in Syria, and the immediate lifting of the siege on the Yarmouk camp, and the return of residents to Husseneia and Sbeina camps.

The AGPS stressed, in its statement, on the necessity of the official Palestinian bodies and factions to assume its responsibilities towards this tragedy, as well as the UNRWA need to carry out its role in providing basic services to the Palestinian Syrian refugees, , and exercise pressure on the international community to provide international protection for them.

The statement pointed out that the group has documented "2560" Palestinian victim were killed, till this day, because of the war in Syria, while the siege on the Yarmouk camp still imposed for more than 511 days, including 82 days and the homes are without water, the group also noted that the people of Husseiniya and Sbana camps still outside their camps because of preventing them from returning to it over a year ago, since the militias belonging to the system are still preventing people from returning without any field reason.

The group also noted that about 70% of the space of Daraa camp have been destroyed due to the repeated shelling and clashes, confirming that the Palestinian Syrian refugees who were displaced to the neighboring cities suffer of the legal, economic and health difficulties, due to the weakness of relief assistance provided to them on the one hand and legal obstacles that encounter in those countries on the other hand. Victims

The Young man Ali Al Hajji was killed due to a gunshot by unknown



group while he was at Al Orouba neighborhood southern the Yarmouk camp in Damascus.

The refugee Mohammed Bakeir from the Yarmouk camp was killed in a car accident, while he was with a group of refugees from Sudan to Libya, amid reports talk about a number of the victims, while the group could not make sure of this news. It is mentions that a number of Palestinian and Syrian refugees are taking the overland route from Sudan to Libya and then to Europe after most states prevent the entry to a systematic manner.

Hamza Abbas and Basil Al Darbi from Handarat camp were also killed during the clashes in the vicinity of their camp indicated that they are members of al-Quds Brigade affiliated on the regular Syrian army.

Recent Updates

Violent battles broke out days ago in the vicinity of Handarat camp, which the Syrian regular army and Al Quds brigades are trying to regain control of it, where the camp is controlled by some groups affiliated on the Syrian armed opposition, it is noteworthy that all the people in the camp have been displaced following the violent clashes that broke out a few months ago, which ended in the control of groups belonging to the Syrian armed opposition.



On the other hand, the rest of Daraa camp people are living in a state of anxiety following the spread of the snipers on the vicinity of the camp, where several cases of sniping recorded during the last period, the residents are still suffering from a lack of basic services due to the destruction of large areas of the camp after repeated shelling.

In the same context, the documentation team in the AGPS confirmed that the number of victims from Daraa camp since the beginning of the war in Syria has reached 188 casualties, including (107) were killed by the bombing, (25) have been shot by a sniper, (23) was shot, (3) due to torture, while (19) refugees were field executed, (7) refugees for unknown reasons, Two refugees as a result of car bombing, and another died as a result of lack of medical care, and another burned to death, as a refugee was killed by white weapon.

In the Yarmouk camp, a number of civil work bodies and committees has continued to secure some water to residents of the camp in an effort to mitigate the effects of water cuts for families since (82) days, and in the same context, "Jafra" Foundation continued its campaign "Drop of Water" in order to secure water to the people of the Yarmouk refugee camp, where services team have implemented reclamation and operation of four wells inside the camp, as the reform of the two pumps to be used to extract water, as well as the creation of five water storage points around the camp, especially in areas distant from the available water sources.

In addition to disinfect water in order to become drinkable, with the aim of alleviating the suffering of the camp's residents who complain of continued water cuts from their homes and lanes for more than two months and a half.

The regular army and groups of the Popular Front - General Command continue to impose their tightened siege at the camp for more than a year and a half.

In Jordan, Palestinian Syrian refugees in Cyber City Compound renewed their appeal to human rights organizations, the PLO, the Palestinian factions and UNRWA to solve their problem and extend a helping hand to them, where they feel that they are isolated from the outside world and treated as detainees in a Camp more like Closed security detention center, where they are being detained and not allowed to go out only within the limitations and guarantees, indicated that the number of Palestinian refugees displaced from Syria to Jordan is "10, 687" Palestinian refugees according to UNRWA statistics.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 29/11/2014

- *The number of Palestinian refugee victims in Syria has reached 2560.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 512 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 595 days, water was cut for 82 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.*
- *41 Palestinian refugees were killed outside of Syria.*
- *96 PLA members were killed due to Clashes in Syria.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 414 days respectively.*
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 384 days respectively.*
- ***Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for 584 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- ***Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost 229 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.*

- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:*** - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
- ***Al Nairab Camp:*** - Power is still cut for more than a year.
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.
