### **Victims**

Three Palestinians were killed yesterday after a bombing that targeted Khan Dannoun camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus city, the victims are MoheyAddinAwad , Ahmed Abdallah Mustafa Alsowalmi and the child DiabMousa Mahmoud.

### **Recent Updates in Syria**

A number of mortar shells targeted Khan Dannoun refugee camp in Damascus city, killed three victims and lift a number of injuries. This camp is witnessing a state of tension for several days because of the high military actions in its surroundings.

It is noteworthy that the camp receives hundreds of Palestinian families displaced from their camps because of the bombing and blockade. On the other hand Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city witnessed a state of panic as a result of heavy shelling that hit the areas surrounding the camp with a number of explosive barrels. As amounts of aid distributed at Yarmouk refugee camp to the besieged people, accompanied with allowing the return of a number of elementary students to the camp after they completed the official exams.





## Lebanon

Lebanese authorities allowed a number of Palestinian Syrian students, who were doing their official exams in Syria, to enter Lebanon, yesterday, where there are the rest of their families, while the Lebanese still prevent the entry of Palestinian Syrians. Noteworthy that Lebanon has taken a series of procedures against the Palestinians refugees from Syria which would limit the entering and staying in it.

In a related context, a number of Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon sit-in in front of the UNRWA Office at Ein Al Helwe camp , in protest at their poor living in Lebanon , the protesters demanded, by a memorandum handed over to the camp director of UNRWA, to interfere to solve the problem of preventing the Palestinians of Syria from access to Lebanon , and the problem of renewal of residencies and the consequent of high cost, in light of the deteriorating material conditions of the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon .



For its part, the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria issued a report entitled "Palestinian refugees from Syria to Lebanon and the only





option..." where the report highlights the legal status of Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon and what they witnessed of bothering under many names, including " organization, settlement, prevention, deportation " and all of them ends with one result that is: the Palestinian Syrian refugee undesirable in Lebanon.

The report also indicates the discrimination amongst the Syrian refugees in Lebanon, in addition to decisions related to Palestinian Syrian which form a new factor of risk that is sweeping the Palestinian community of Syria. Palestinians of Syria has managed to choose a way of several ways when they surrounded by danger, managed to escape their family, to save what can be saved. The report also added that the recent Lebanese decisions confiscated their only option to stay as a refugee in Lebanon until the end of the Syrian crisis , but it imposed a new option which is to return from where he/she came sooner or later, regardless the Influence of what is going on out there on his/her life . Is there any adjuster for the refugee or anyone to cry for him? ??
