“Albania Prepares to Deport 21 Palestinian Syrian Refugees to Greece”

Albania

Albanian authorities issued a decision to deport 21 Palestinians of Syria refugees, who were detained in charge of illegal immigration. Albania will deport the remaining detainees in batches to Greece, while the group received a names list of refugees who will be deported,

They are: Awwad Mohammed, Hassan Hassan, Imad Magharbi, Ali Ali, Loua'i Ali, Adnan Mahmoud, Hassan Fadi, Mohamed Abdel Daiem, Abla Abdel- Aziz, Omar Tayar, Saleh Maria, Ahmed Hassan, Muhannad Muhammad, Muhammad Tayar, Osman Nadi, Walid Al Falaj, Deia'a Al Dien Ali, Ahmed Ali, Bilal Ali, Wissam Mahmoud and Hamza Saleh.

Victims

"Zakareia Al Masri " was killed by a sniper's shot while he was collecting firewood in Al Tadamon area at Yarmouk refugee camp.

Recent Updates in Syria

Heavy shelling targeted different areas at Yarmouk refugee camp in Damascus, leaving a number of wounded, coincided with clashes between groups of Free Army and members of the Popular Front – Public Command.

It is noteworthy that the camp has been exposed to heavy shelling in the last few days, in addition to the spread of snipers in the streets adjacent to the camp, causing a state of tension in the ranks of people fearing of hunting, where the main streets in the camp became easy targets to the Regulars Army snipers who are frequently targeting passers.

About living aspect, water cut continue for long hours for the fifth day, respectively, for most areas of the camp, in addition to the complete power outage over a year ago.

In a related context, people of Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city suffer from a severe bread crisis, after running out of many of the basic materials in the camp due to the interruption of roads connecting between the camp and the city center because of the clashes and heavy shelling which target surrounding areas.

Two children from Alnairab Camp has injured after a mortar shell landed on a civilian homes in Aleppo, northern Syria. Dara'a camp, southern Syria, was targeted with a number of mortar shells, and mentions that a large number of houses had become unsuitable for housing because of the repeated shelling.

On the other hand, Mr. Ahmed Jibril the Secretary -General of the PFLP - General Command and his family, as well as Dr Talal Naji the Secretary-General Assistant of the PFLP - General Command “participated in the presidential Syrian election, note that the law 260 of 1956 does not allow any Palestinian _ Syrian to practice any Syrian political rights relevant to nomination and election.

Austria

Palestinian community in Austria organized an open meeting with Palestinian of Syria refugees who fled their camps in Syria to escape from bombardment and siege. People of the Palestinian community in Austria expressed their solidarity with the Palestinians of Syria, noted that Mr. Salah Abdel Shafi, the Palestinian ambassador in Austria, and a number of Arab refugees participated in the meeting.

Release

Mr. Abdullah Osman from Al A'edein camp in Homs was released the day before, after being arrest since the beginning of last April. Also Mr. Walid Khaled Azzam from Alnairab camp was released yesterday after being arrest for more than nine months.

Majdi Orabi, from Yarmouk refugee camp, was missed two days ago, after he had finished the first course of the high school examination. It is worth mentioning that Orabi resides at Saied Ibn Al Aas Institute _ Al Aliance with a group of students who came out of the Yarmouk refugee camp for several months to complete their studies.
