“Turkey Issues a Decision to Vacate Kls Shelter of Single Youth, the Border Guards Assault and Beat Palestinian Syrian Refugees”



Kls Shelter in Turkey

- Three Palestinian refugees were killed in Syria.
- Bombardment and clashes in the Yarmouk camp.
- A state of unsecure experienced by the residents of Al Raml camp in Latakia due to the strict security procedures in the entrances and exits of the camp.
- Strict living crises experienced by the residents of Jaramana camp.
- Lebanon issues a decision to prevent the non Lebanese student to enroll in its schools.

Turkey

The Turkish border guard forces severely beat and assault Palestinian Syrian refugees from the Yarmouk camp after crossing into Turkish territory from Syria via Qamishli road to escape from the hell of war in Syria, and for fear of arrest and torture.

In a related context, the Turkish authorities issued a decision to vacate the Kls shelter of Palestinian Syrian young singles, and for implementing this decision, the General Authority for Palestine Refugees in the temporary Syrian government, as the responsible body for the center, informs the young singles inside the center of this decision, which gave them a deadline to leave to avoid any action that may be taken by the Turkish authorities against them. This has been justified by the Turkish authorities that the decision came to put an end to the problems caused by the presence of young unmarried couples with families in one place.

On the other hand, a delegation from the Turkish Association of Vidar visited Kls shelter in order to check on the situation of Palestinian Syrian refugees and to alleviate their pain and provide their needs.

Victims

Three Palestinian refugees were killed due to the continuing conflict in Syria, one of them due to torture.



The Palestinian refugee "Tayseir Bahloul" from Yarmouk camp, Moroccans Street, was killed due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime.

Saeid Ayoub (56 years) from Yarmouk camp died in a hospital in Damascus as a result of lack of medical care in the camp, it should be noted that he has been out of the camp three days ago because he infected with Pneumonitis.

The young man "Taher Mohammed," one of the (PFLP-GC) members from Khan AL Sheih camp, was killed due to the clashes that broke out in the Yarmouk camp between armed groups and the regular army alongside with the General Command.

Recent Updates

Heavy shelling in the Yarmouk camp targeted different areas with a number of shells which resulted in a number of injuries coincided with clashes that broke out between armed groups inside the camp and members of PFGC.

Meanwhile, the strict siege imposed in the Yarmouk camp is still continues for more than a year, while the rest of its residents are suffering of severe shortage in food supplies and medical services.



According to documented statistics of the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria, about 155 Palestinian refugees were killed due to the starvation and the lack of medical care.

On the other hand, a state of insecure and instability prevailed Al Nairab camp as a result of the deteriorating security situation in the surrounding areas, and some of its residents were engaged in the fighting alongside with Syrian Army, which expose it to the bombing of different places and resulted in a number of victims and injuries.

In the same context, our correspondent at Al Neirab camp insure the news about the injury of Em Amer Mghamis 45 years, was shot in her home as a result of random gunfire from an unknown source and she has been transferred to the city of Aleppo for treatment.

In the meantime, despite the relative quite experienced by Al Raml camp in Lathakia, but a state of discomfort and insecurity spread among its residents as a result of the strict security procedures at the entrances and exits of the camp, and the fear of raids and arrests carried out by Syrian security forces between now and then.

On the other hand, residents of the camp complain of difficult situations, high prices, lack of food and the weakness of the cellular communications network.

The residents of Jaramana camp suffers from big economic problems, the most important is the great overpopulation in the camp, due to the displacement of a large number of the people of Hosseinieh compound, Yarmouk camp, Al Thiabeia and AL Bahdaleia, and some towns and villages in East Gouta.

Our correspondent also noted that the number of inhabitants of the classrooms is three families, at a minimum, in addition to the crowded houses, in the absence of bathing areas in schools, what may cause outbreaks of many diseases, in addition to the education problems resulting from the migration of students from their originally schools, and put them in a rented schools outside the camp.

Thus, the residents and dignitaries of AL Husseinia camp continues to work aimed to return the camp residents to their homes, especially after the regular army, (PFLP-GC), Fatah al-Intifada and the Struggle Front , controlled Hosseinieh area, including the camp on 10/11/2013.



Arrest

The Syrian security forces arrested the Palestinian refugee Ahmed Orsan Turkey from Al Nairab camp in Aleppo.

Release

The young man Iyad Akram Al Touba from Al Aedein camp in Homs was released after being detained for about a month.

Missing

The young Ahmed Mohammed Al Shaer was missed on 24-8-2014 while he was leaving the Libyan town of Zowara on a boat heading to Italy; there is no news about him till the moment.

It is referred that dozens of Palestinian Syrian and Syrian refugees were missed during the past days because of "Death Boats" heading to Europe to escape the hell of the ongoing war in Syria searching for a save shelter to protect them of the snipping, the bombing and the arrest.

Lebanon

The Lebanese Education Minister issued a decision that prevents the non Lebanese students to enroll the Lebanese schools, this decision fears thousands of Palestinian Syrian and Syrian refugee families about the future of their children.

In turn, the Palestinian Association for Human Rights (Shahid) contacted the Office of the Minister of Education to inquire about the merits of the decision and what it could pose a risk to thousands of students from the Palestinian Syrian and Syrian refugee displaced to Lebanon, where according to the minister's office that there are explanatory statement will be issued today regarding this decision which may include new requirements for enrollment of Palestinian Syrian and Syrians students to Lebanese public schools.

It is noteworthy that the Palestinians from Syria students who displaced to Lebanon are suffering of huge difficulties such as the difference between the Syrian and the Lebanese curriculum, where the Lebanese curriculum rely mainly on foreign language teaching, unlike the Syrian curriculum.
