*The effects of shelling on the Vicinity of Khan AL Sheih camp*

- Displacement waves for Palestinian refugees from Al Muzaireib compound in Dara'a.
- Spread of drugs addiction phenomenon in Al Aedein camp in Homs.
- The Action Group: 943 Palestinian refugees were killed in Yarmouk camp till the end of July 2014.

### **Victims**

*Three Palestinians were killed in Syria, one of them under torture, the victims are:*

- *Saied Abu Rashid, from Yarmouk camp Al Orouba Street, was killed under torture in the Syrian Regime prisons.*
- *Anas Al Nabulsi was killed due to the heavy shelling of Douma city in Damascus city.*
- *Mostafa Hosny Jomaa from Al Aedein camp in Hamma was killed due to the ongoing conflict in Syria.*

### **Recent Updates**

*Repeated shelling with artillery shells targeted Jaramana camp in Damascus city. Where five shells fallen on separate places resulted only in material damages. The camp is still receiving more of Palestinian families that displaced to it because of the deterioration of the situation which led to the high prices of rent houses, if they found, because of the continuous requests.*



*The effects of shelling on Jaramana camp*

*A state of tension prevailed in Khan Al Sheih camp because of the bombing of the adjacent areas with explosive barrels resulted in a heavy explosion sounds. Meanwhile, an explosive barrel targeted the camp but did not explode in Fatema Street near the camp. The camp suffers of an acute shortage of services and medical materials because the cut of the roads that connect the camp with the surrounding areas.*

*Al Muzareeb compound for the Palestinian refugees in Dara'a witnesses frequent displacement waves that their number is about 8000 refugees where the frequent bombing with explosive barrels obliged them to leave the town to the surroundings areas and Palestinian camps. The frequent bombing resulted in more than 20 victims in addition to the huge destruction in many facilities inside the compound such as UNRWA schools.*

*In terms of living conditions, Al Muzareeb coumpound suffers of the continues drinking water cut since about five days, where residents have to buy it through tankers in addition to the suffering of losing many of basic food supplies and its high prices if it is found.*



*The compound is receiving hundreds of families who were displaced from Dara'a camp because of the heavy shelling that destroyed huge parts of it. Drugs addiction phenomenon is still spreading rapidly in Homs amongst youth, where NGOs in the camp warned of the negative consequences of the spread of this phenomenon.*

*PRCS inside the camp held several workshops to discuss the reasons and methods of the spread of this phenomenon and steps that should be taken to get rid of it.*

*It is worth mentioning that most of the youth are suffering from unemployment due to the tense security situation in the camp and its vicinity, forcing many of them to leave their work.*

*On the other hand, the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria announced, in the statistics published on its Web site, that it has documented the death of 943 victims in Yarmouk camp at Damascus out of 2402 Palestinian victims have been documented in Syria until the end of July, including 154 refugees died because of siege imposed on the camp over a year ago, where the checkpoints of the regular army and groups of the Popular Front - General Command prevent the introduction of basic materials, medical and fuel as well as they prevent the movement of people through checkpoints.*

*Meanwhile, people of Al Aedein camp in Hama are suffering of growing living crises, notably the crises of bread and food, where they are suffering of a shortage in the amounts of bread in the camp which increases the daily burden, in addition to the high prices of basic food supplies and the loss of many of the brands in the markets of the camp as unemployment increases the suffering of the people, where most of the residents were forced to leave the business because of the work stoppage in most companies and factories where they work.*
