



***“Action Group: 461 Palestinian Syrian Refugees were killed During the First Half of 2014”***



- A Palestinian refugee was killed due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons.
- Bombing targets the vicinity of Khan Al Sheih camp and resulted in two victims.
- Distribution of some food meals to the besieged residents of the Yarmouk camp.
- The Syrian security arrests three refugees from Al Aedein camp.
- ISIS releases a Palestinian refugee after kidnapping him three months ago.
- The Syrian security releases a Palestinian refugee.

### **Recent Updates**

*The documentation team of the AGPS announced that the number of Palestinian refugee victims who were killed in the first half of 2014 due to the ongoing war in Syria has reached (461) victims, including (219) victims in the Yarmouk camp, (49) in Daraa camp, (24) in Aleppo, (16) in Khan Al Sheih camp, (5) in Khan Dannun camp, (8) in Jermana camp, (3) in Al Aedein camp in Homs (4) in Al Aedein camp in Hama, (3) in Husseinieh compound, (5) in Al Raml camp in Latakia , (1) in Al Sayeda Zainab camp, (48) in the city of Damascus and its suburb in addition to (76) victims in different parts of Syria.*

*In the same context, the young man "Ayham Abdul Rahim" was killed due to torture in the Syrian regime's prisons, it is mentioned that the group had documented the names of "277" refugees who were died under torture in Syria.*

*On the other hand, heavy shelling targeted the vicinity of Khan Al Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus suburb and resulted in two victims, not recognized identities yet, it is mentioned that, during the past three days, the pace of military actions have risen in the vicinity of the camp where the warplanes launched missile strikes in a number of farms. The camp is still suffers from low health services where the UNRWA clinic, the only remain clinic in the camp, only provide few simple health services.*



*In Damascus, "Give Charity Foundation" distributed some food meals to the besieged people of the Yarmouk camp, where the camp is suffering from a severe shortage of food and medical supplies, due to the continued siege imposed on the camp about year and a half by the regular army and groups of PFGC, which resulted in the death of "157" Palestinian refugees who died due to malnutrition and medical care shortage in their camp. It is noteworthy that the water was cut from all the houses of the camp is still going on for more than "88" days, it comes under the extreme full scarcity of fuel and electricity.*



#### ***Distributing food meals in Yarmouk camp***

*In Homs, the Syrian security forces arrested three Palestinian refugees from Al Aedein camp in Homs: "Khaledoun Moussa Shatara" in his forties, displaced residents of Al Nairab camp in Aleppo, originally from Tarsheiha village in Palestine, "Mohammed Awad " was arrested from his home in Al Aedein camp, he is in his fifties, originally from Tirat Haifa village in Palestine, "Raja Hassan Ghannam " was arrested on 01.11.2014, from his home in Al Aedein refugee camp, in his forties , he is originally from Tirat Haifa village in Palestine.*

*In a related context, r what is known as "Isis Organization" released a Palestinian refugee, "Basil Haitham Hourani" after kidnapping him for about three months, it is worth mentioning that Al-Hourani is from Al Nairab camp in Aleppo and was kidnapped while trying to reach Turkey via northern Syria.*



*Meanwhile, the Syrian security released the Palestinian refugee "Ahmed Hammoud" in his fifties, originally from Tarsheiha village in Palestine after being detained for several months.*

### ***The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 5/12/2014***

- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for **518** days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than **600** days, water was cut for **88** days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached **157** victims.
- ***41*** Palestinian refugees were killed outside of Syria.
- ***96*** PLA members were killed due to Clashes in Syria.
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **420** days respectively.
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **390** days respectively.
- ***Handarat Camp:*** - Residents have left the camp for **590** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - It is now almost **235** days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:*** - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
