Recent Updates

The Muzereeb in Dara'a city was exposed to bombings by the warplanes in an explosive barrel. Our correspondent couldn't know the damages till now. It is worth mentioning that there is a Palestinian of Syria refugees' compound in the Muzereeb in addition that the town receives hundreds of Palestinian families who left Dara'a camp because of the bombings.

Though the signing of the neutralization agreement ten days ago the siege is still imposed on the Yarmouk camp. The Yarmouk camp is still under a strict siege by the Regular army and the popular front general command since about a year. The Siege on the Yarmouk camp led to an acute shortage of the basic materials and food items in addition to the stop of its clinics and hospitals except Palestine hospital which works in its minimum capacity. The medical staff is the most prominent cause of stopping the health facilities. Moreover the Yarmouk camp suffers of the power cut and the damage of some parts of hospitals in the repeated bombings that targeted it. The bombings targeted Al Basel and Fayes Halawa hospitals for more than once during the last months which resulted in a big dame of the hospitals in addition to injuries and victims.

In a related context, the Action Group for the Palestinians of Syria declared that 926 Palestinian of Syria refugees were killed in the Yarmouk refugees camp till May 2014. 151 Palestinian of Syria refugees died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the siege that is imposed since about a year.

About the causes that led to their death, the Action Group said in its statistics, which was published earlier, that the siege, bombings, sniping, clashes and torturing to death are all from the famous causes of refugees' death. It is worth mentioning that the Action Group in its detailed statistics, that was published last month, that 2290 Palestinians of Syria Refugees died till May 2014.

Khan Al Shaih Palestinian refugees camp witnessed a calm state coincided with a notified increase of the electricity hours in the camp's houses. The markets of the camp suffer of a severe shortage of the food and medical materials because the repeated cut of roads that connect the camp with the city center, due to the violent bombings and clashes that the camp and the surrounded areas witnessed.

Egypt

The Palestinian Syrian refugees live in a state of instability in Egypt. The refugees complain from not getting the residencies till now without any causes from the Egyptian authorities.

The refugee Mahmoud told the Action Group's correspondent in Egypt that despite the introduction of all requested documents to get the residency such as , rent house contract, documents of children joining schools, copies of passports ...etc, the Egyptian authorities didn't give him the residency.

Mahmoud added that the delay of issuing the residencies let them live in a state of instability especially because of the political tension that Egypt lives. Mahmoud mentions that the political and economic situation obliged tens of the Palestinian Syrian families in Egypt to risk their souls



and ride the so called death boats for searching about safety and stability in the European countries.

It is worth mentioning that the Egyptian Authorities detained a number of Palestinian Syrian refugees a week ago after capturing them under the pretext of trying to migrate illegally. The Palestinian Syrian Refugees contain amongst them 8 women and 15 children.

Lebanon

The Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon suffer of complex crises. Legal and Economic crises are the most prominent crises. The Lebanese authorities impose serious procedures on the Palestinian Syrian Refugees especially the procedures of entering Lebanon and the possibilities to extend their residencies.

These procedures led to separate families where a number of Palestinian Syrian refugees in Syria can't join their families in Lebanon. On the economic situation, the Palestinian Syrian refugees' families suffer of the high cost of living and the High prices of rent houses in addition to the inability of the refugees to work for some reasons such as the legal status and the high rate of unemployment in Lebanon.
