“Explosive Barrels Target Khan Al Sheih Camp in Damascus City”

- A Palestinian was killed in Syria.

Victims

Mohammed Sameer Jouhar(21years) from Al Muzareeb compound died in Dara'a city, which increases the Palestinians of Syria victims toll to 2507 victims that were documented by the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria.

Recent Updates

The Syrian warplanes targeted the eastern street of Khan Al Sheih camp with explosive barrels which resulted in mass damage to the civilians' houses, till this moment there is no news about victims or wounded amongst the residents. It is mentioned that the camp and the surrounding areas witnessed an increase in the rate of the special military operations in the last period after the battles between the Regular Army and Groups of the Free Army in the surrounding area, Al Qunitera city.

On the other hand, a Palestinian young man, who is detained in the Greece Cyprus, tried to commit a suicide protesting on the bad situation that he suffers of and demanding at the same time to be granted a residency in one of the European countries to be allowed to get out of the detention camp in Greece. It is mentioned that the Greek authorities detained him and his companions while they were trying to reach the Italian coasts after their boat, which was carrying them near the Greek costs, was malfunctioned.

On a different context, the water cut on the houses of the Yarmouk camp in Damascus continues for about a month which increases the suffering of the residents, where the power cut also continues for more than a year , coincided with the strict siege that is imposed on the camp by the Regular Army and the PFGC for about 15 months. Meanwhile, the checkpoints prevent the entry of food supplies and basic materials to the camp which led to 155 victims because of the shortage of food and medical care due to the strict siege.

In a similar context, hundreds of Jermana camp residents suffer of rough living crises , the economic crises is the most prominent where people complain of the high prices of rent houses and food materials in addition to the spread of unemployment.

It is referred that hundreds of Palestinian families were displaced to the camp during the previous months due to the siege, bombing and clashes that targeted their camps.

In Turkey, the Palestinians of Syria Committee that follows the Turkish Palestinian Solidarity Association "FIDDER" distributed financial aids to the Palestinian refugees in Kilis to all residents in the center, which are 98 families. The committee also distributed a quantity of qurbani meat to the Palestinian families in the south-east of Turkey in all of Gazi, antep, Kilis, Urfa, NZb, Mrash, Kilis Camp1, and Gilan Pienaar.



It is noteworthy that dozens of Palestinian Syrian families were forced to leave the camps because of the siege, the shelling, and the repeated clashes and entered Turkish territory illegally since the Turkish authorities impose on the Palestinian Syrians visas to enter its territory while its embassies in neighboring countries, especially Lebanon refusing to issue visas for Palestinian Syrian refugees forcing most of them to enter Turkish territory across the Syrian-Turkish border illegally to escape from the horrors of war in Syria, with unofficial statistics indicate that the number of Palestinian Syrian refugees in Turkey has exceeded three thousand refugees.
