“Military Service is the Most Prominent Causes that Forces Palestinian Youth to Leave Syria”

Recent Updates

A state of anxiety controls the Palestinian youth refugees in Syria, where the regular army checkpoints scattered over large areas scrutinize them and arrest those who escape of the mandatory enrollment in the ranks of the Palestine Liberation Army service.

The Syrian regular army involving in the battles increasing those concerns, prompting most of the young people to leave Syria and flee to neighboring countries, and states that the AGPS have documented "96" name for recruits and officers from the Palestine Liberation Army who had died due to the ongoing clashes between the regular army and groups of the Syrian armed opposition.

In the same context, the Palestinian refugee "Hamza Toukhi" from Jermana camp, Abu Nuri neighborhood, was killed due to the war in Syria.

On the other hand, bombing targeted Loube Street at the Yarmouk camp and resulted in limited material damage only, while the siege imposed on the camp still continuing for about a year and a half, as the water cuts from the camp for 89 days respectively, on the other hand UNRWA managed to enter some school books as distributed by a UNRWA representatives on alternative schools in the camp in an attempt to mitigate the consequences of the siege.



Bombing targeted Yarmouk camp

It is noteworthy that many schools in Yarmouk was bombed like Fallujah school that was bombed by Syrian warplanes on 12/16/2012 and led to



the fall of the number of victims, as some schools were theft, looting and arson.

In the same context, Italian Navy announced that it has saved "556" refugees the day before yesterday, after their boats stopped off the Italian coast, it was also pointed out that one of the refugees was killed after suffering multiple degrees of burns while not know his nationality yet, it is noteworthy that the Italian authorities had announced, earlier, they recovered "17" body of refugees who were trying to reach across the sea, but it gave no details on the nationalities of them.

In Turkey, Palestinians of Syria Committee in Turkey has begun the implementation of winter aid project submitted by the World Assembly of Muslim Youth, where it distributed winter blankets on some needy Syrian Palestinian families, it is noteworthy that the project lasted several days, so the Commission to complete the distribution of cash assistance provided by the Turkish humanitarian relief Organization in Al Islah city and Karakhan.

Civil Work Committees

The Pharmacy of Palestine Charity Committee continues to distribute drugs free of charge to the patients of the Yarmouk camp in an attempt to alleviate the consequences of the siege imposed by the regular army and groups of the Popular Front - General Command of the camp about a year and a half ago.





The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 6/12/2014

- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 519 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 601 days, water was cut for 89 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 421 days respectively.
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 391 days respectively.
- ***Handarat Camp:*** - Residents have left the camp for 591 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - It is now almost 236 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:*** - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
- ***Al Nairab Camp:*** - Power is still cut for more than a year.
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.
