Recent Updates

One of the residents of Yarmouk camp in Damascus was shot by snipers in the foot while he was waiting to get aid near Al Righa square. Meanwhile, the checkpoints of the Regular Army and groups of the Public Front-General Command, who besieged the camp for more than a year, allowed the entry of some aid that distributed to the besieged people.

Our correspondent confirmed the news about the entry of the initiative delegation yesterday, in order to consolidate the ceasefire and complete what was agreed upon between Syrian opposition groups inside the camp and the Syrian authorities.

This comes after the clashes that broke out at the entrance of the camp between Syrian opposition groups and groups of the regular army backed by Palestinian groups loyal to it, while a Palestinian woman was dead due to these clashes and a member of the Syrian regime and another member of the General Command.

Bombing is still targeting Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city, as heavy explosions were heard due to the bombing, coincided with repeated sniping of Zkia road that connect the camp to the adjacent areas. Mini bus was shot by sniper with no details about injuries, while the camp is suffering of severe shortage of food and medical supplies because of the repeated banditry.

Violent clashes broke out in Al Nairab camp in Aleppo between groups of Syrian opposition and groups of Syrian Army at Al Sheikh Lotfi area and Al Nairab crossroad, as the camp is fully controlled by the regular army and some Palestinian groups loyal to it.

On the other hand, Khan Dannoun camp in Damascus city is still suffering of drinking water crises, because of the water cut and the erratic power supply, forcing residents to buy water through tankers at high prices and in small quantities.

The camp receives hundreds of Palestinian families who were displaced from their camps because of the shelling, clashes and siege.

Meanwhile, Daraa camp is suffering of a severe shortage of health and food services, in addition to the lack of water due to the shelling and repeated clashes which broke out in and around the camp, which led to



the destruction of large parts of the camp forcing the residents to leave their homes and move to the neighboring compounds in fear on their lives and the lives of their children.

Statistics

Action Group for Palestinians of Syria announced that 961 Palestinian Syrian refugees were killed in Syria because of the direct targeting of their areas, as the Group said, in a detailed statistics published on its site at the beginning of this month, that the bombing resulted in the death of 961 Palestinian Syrian refugees till the end of July 2014.

The Group confirmed that 33 refugees were killed due to the targeted of their areas with chemical weapon , while another two refugees were killed due to the Israeli bombing in Gaza strip, as the majority of victims were killed because of the bombing of their camps with explosive barrels, rockets and mortars.

Civil Work Committees

AFAD Turkish Organization visited a shelter center yesterday in Kls city, in order to check on the conditions of Palestinian refugees from Syria to Turkey, and to distribute food aid to alleviate their suffering.

Meanwhile, one of the Turkish families visited a shelter center for Palestinian refugees in Kls city, where they brought some sweets and juice for Children as an expression of solidarity with refugees, which left a positive impact on the hearts of children and parents.

It is reported that hundreds of Palestinian Syrian families has fled to Turkey due to the bombing and blockade, where most of them are suffering of economic and legal problems, where most of them entered Turkey illegally because the Turkish embassy in Lebanon refused to give them visas to Turkish territory without giving reasons.
