“A Delegation from the Yarmouk Camp to Try to Revive the New Neutralization Agreement, and Three Families Return Back to the camp”



The delegation meeting in Yarmouk camp

Recent Updates

Our correspondent in the Yarmouk camp in Damascus confirmed the entry of a delegation from outside the camp in an attempt to revive neutralization agreement, and the reporter added that until this moment, any information did not leak about the meeting, which included all of, Al Sheikh "Mohammed Alian" and Walid Kurdi, in addition to a number of representatives of groups affiliated on the Syrian armed opposition.

Meanwhile the water was cut from the homes of the camp for 90 days respectively, in light of the continued siege imposed by members of the regular army and groups of the PFGC for 520 days. It is mentioned that the siege resulted in the death of 157 Palestinian refugees due to malnutrition and medical care shortage.

In the same context, Palestinian Red Crescent organization began a campaign to vaccinate against polio, at its headquarter in Deir Yassin, where the campaign include all children in the camp who are under five years.

In Daraa camp, south of Syria, people are suffering of acute shortage of medical and humanitarian services in addition to water cuts for more than seven months, forcing them to resort to use the artesian wells.

Generally, the camp is witnessing significant weakness of relief services, where UNRWA has stopped providing services within the camp due to the repeated shelling and clashes, which led to the destruction of about 70% of the homes.

In a related context, the people of Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus suburb are suffering of poor medical services, since the only near hospital has stopped working for more than a year, as only an UNRWA clinic working which provides some simple medical services to the people, while all roads linking between the camp and the city center still closed except for "Zakia -Khan Al Sheih."

On the other hand, the general director of UNRWA, "Michael Kingsley," made an inspection visit to the UNRWA facilities at Al Nairab camp in Aleppo, the visit comes in light of the bad economic conditions suffered by the residents of the camp, where unemployment is widespread among the people.

Meanwhile, the camp and surrounding areas are experiencing frequent clashes because the camp is next to the Neirab Military Airport. On another hand, Palestinians of Syria Committee in Turkey distributed aids to the people of Kilis center, and some of the families living in the city, where they distributed some blankets and carpets.

Palastine Charity Committee launched cleaning campaign entitled "campaign for a cleaner camp" with the aim of removing the rubble and waste from the streets of the Yarmouk refugee camp to prevent the spread of epidemics and diseases, while the Services team began to collect waste and debris in a specific place to be transported out of camp.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 7/12/2014

- **The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for **520** days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than **602** days, water was cut for **90** days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached **157** victims.
- **Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **422** days respectively.
- **Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **392** days respectively.
- **Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for **592** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- **Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost **237** days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- **Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
- **Khan Danoun Camp:** - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
- **Al Nairab Camp:** - Power is still cut for more than a year.
- **Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.
