- **Three Palestinians were killed in Syria.**
- **A resident of Khan Al Sheih camp was injured on Zakia Road in Khan Al Shieh camp.**

- **Bombing targeted Al Taiba town which surrounds Khan Danoun camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus city.**
- **A number of Palestinian refugees were released from the Syrian Regime prisons.**
- **A recorded voice message was published by detained Palestinians of Syria refugees in Egypt which contains appeals to the International organizations to interfere for their release.**

Victims

Three Palestinian refugees were killed in Syria under torture, including a woman and other two were killed due to the clashes between the Syrian opposition forces and the regular army.

The victims are:

A Palestinian refugee "Samira Ahmed Sahli", she was born in (1969) from the Yarmouk camp. She was killed due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons, bringing the total number of victims of Palestinian refugees who were died due to torture in Syrian prisons to "272" until yesterday according to the documented statistics for the Action group for Palestinians of Syria refugees. Meanwhile, each of the two young men "Ashraf Alamory," and "Khalid Saleh Ali", were dead as a result of the clashes between the Syrian opposition forces and the regular army alongside with Palestinian factions.

Recent Updates

Khalid Nahar from Khan Al Sheih camp was injured by a sniper shot. According to our correspondent's testimony inside the camp, Khalid was injured in his right foot by a sniper on the road of Zakia Khan Al Sheih



while returning to the camp. He was transferred to a hospital outside the town and he is in a good health.

The people of the camp are complaining of the ongoing closure of all roads that connect the camp with the surrounding areas, except Zakia-Khan Al Sheih road which is used despite the risks they face due to the clashes between the regular army and the free army. The closure of the roads affected negatively on the amount of food comes for camp's people also on the availability of the necessary food supplies provided to the camp. As a result, many kinds of food run out and the prices of other kinds were increased.

The UNRWA has distributed ,for the third consecutive day, the food baskets to families of the Yarmouk refugee camp who are suffer from the ongoing siege on their camp. In addition to the water cut in the entire camp for two months where the people are forced to secure small amounts of water from neighboring areas which increase the living crises a year ago.

In the meantime, violent clashes broke out on the front of Handarat camp between Syrian opposition forces and the regular army, which is trying to demonstrate the Handarat and the camp weeks ago.

It is noteworthy that Handarat, which was inhabited by about twenty thousand of Palestinian and Syrian refugees abandoned by his people on 27.04.2013 because of frequent clashes and shelling, where its residents were displaced their possessions were destroyed besides their homes also a number of victims and injuries were fallen due to the frequent clashes.

A state of tension prevailed the people of Khan Danon camp for a Palestinian refugees near Damascus after hearing the voices of powerful explosions rocked parts of the camp that later identified as a result of the regular army' bombardments at Al Tiba neighborhood and controlled by the forces. Khan Dannun is still harbor thousands of displaced families from the Palestinian refugee camps and neighboring areas. But the main problem facing the residents of the camp is the scarcity of food and medicine, in addition to the high prices and the poverty.

Release

The Syrian security forces released Mari Kali, 55 years, after the arrest lasts to three months, he is from Handarat camp and moved to Al Raml camp in All Lathakeia after the Syrian opposition controlled Handarat camp.

In Homs, Mohammad Ali Alrobh has been released on 05.11.2014, after the arrest that lasted for more than a month. He is in his twenties and originally from Safad-Palestine.

Egypt

The social media websites like Facebook share a recorded voice for a 14-year Palestinian Syrian child named Omar Al Shehaby who was born in the Yarmouk camp Damascus. Omar and his family left the hell of war in Syria to Lebanon then the situation was tightened and his family decided to send him with his brother Abdulla, 21years old, to ride the death boats to the European countries searching for a safe haven in Europe. Omar Al Shehaby added that he entered the Egyptian lands through its airport in the med of September then went to Alexandria.



After a week they launched their trip with a number of the Palestinian Syrian and Syrian families from Alexandria shores but the boat was corrupted after their leave in ten hours. The child continues "after 6 days in the sea with 130 people, including women, children and old men an Egyptian ship rescued us and handled us to the Egyptian Government which detained us in Al Anfoushi Athlet center in Alexandria then to Al Jomruk Police center in Alexandria and then to the Court that decided to deport us to Syria though our request of petition to the Egyptian court.

Accordingly, the detained Palestinians of Syria refugees in the Syrian prisons, who are Omar Al Shehaby 14 years old, Khalid Khalil Khalefa 32 years old, Yousif Ezilden Zaytuna 23 years old and Ramy Ibrahim 27 years old, launched an appeal to the International organizations, Human rights organizations, UN agencies , the PLO , the Palestinian Factions and all concerned sides to interfere with the Egyptian Authorities for not deporting them to Syria and to release them.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics

- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for **491** days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than **574** days, water was cut for **61** days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached **155** victims.
- ***41*** Palestinian refugees were killed outside of Syria .
- ***93*** PLO members were killed due to Clashes in Syria.
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **393** days respectively.
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **362** days respectively.
- ***Handarat Camp:*** - Residents have left the camp for **562** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - It is now almost **208** days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:*** - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
