Mr. Osama Hafawi -30 years- was killed under torture in the prisons of the Syrian Regime.

Victims of Torture

"Action Group for Palestinians of Syria" announced that 200 Palestinian refugees were killed under torture in the prisons of Syrian Regime, since the beginning of the events in Syria, where the group stressed that during June, four Palestinian refugees were killed under torture in the prisons of Syrian Regime.

They are: Muhammad Ali Farhood, Ashraf Abdel Nasser, Ghassan Salaymeh, and Osama Hefawi. The number became 200 victims who were killed under torture, noting that "most of the bodies have not been handed over to their relatives. They contacted only one of the family members of the victims, to inform him to go to the headquarters of the security to receive the victim's belongings and he was not allowed to ask about the corpse. The group demanded, in an earlier statement, the Syrian Regime to reveal the fate of hundreds of Palestinian prisoners, that have unknown fate stressing, that what is happening inside the Syrian prisons for Palestinians is a complete war crime.

Recent Updates

After the world, with all its space, don't receive them, earth is not receiving them as well, where people of Yarmouk refugee camp suffer of a major crisis in the graves, after the earth filled up with their corpse. The number of victims of the Yarmouk refugee camp is 926 refugees were killed until the end of May 2014 according to a detailed statistics published by the Group. It prompted the Services Department of Palestine Charity Commission to search for a replacement. The Commission began to expand the old cemetery in the camp, located in Al Magharba neighborhood, in an attempt to alleviate the crisis.



On the other hand, clashes broke out in Yarmouk refugee camp yesterday evening, between members of the free Army and groups of the Popular Front - General Command, while there has been a state of careful calm in the morning. Residents of the camp refused to receive food aid protesting the continued siege imposed on the camp since ten months, and degrading treatment, accompanied with the beating and detention of women and men by the Syrian security forces, according to a statement released by the residents earlier.

In a related context, heavy shelling with a number of shells targeted Alnairab camp, which led to destruction in civilian homes, meanwhile, phone lines and the Internet returned back to work in Khan Al Sheih camp at Damascus city. Al Himma Youth Group organized a solidarity sit-in, in front of Al Huda mosque, on the Return March martyrs third anniversary, which took place on the anniversary of the Nakba. A group of children carried the martyr's casket of the martyr and a group martyrs names and photos and the Palestine flag. At the end of the vigil, the attendees visited the martyrs memorial monument and put a wreath
